REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 909: Distinctive license; authorize for various purposes.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.94, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

The initial 523 application shall be accompanied by the certification of a 524 licensed physician that (a) the applicant meets the definition of 525 persons with disabilities which limit or impair the ability to 526 walk; and (b) that the physician has determined that the applicant will have the disability for at least five (5) years. The State 527 528 Tax Commission shall prepare and issue to the tax collectors of 529 the various counties, decals for placement on the special license 530 plates. The decals shall bear thereon the month in which the 531 license plate was issued and the year in which the special license 532 plate will expire. The special license plate issued under this 533 section is valid for the period of time that the license tag 534 attached upon a motor vehicle is issued pursuant to Section 535 27-19-31(1).
