## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1132: School nurse program; establish under State Department of Education and provide funding for.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 13 **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known as the Mary Kirkpatrick
- 14 Haskell-Mary Sprayberry Public School Nurse Act of 2007.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** (1) The State Department of Education is
- 16 designated as the state agency responsible for the administration
- 17 and supervision of the school nurse program as an education and
- 18 wellness curriculum in the public schools of the State of
- 19 Mississippi. The public school nurse program administered by the
- 20 State Department of Education shall be known and may be cited as
- 21 the "Mary Kirkpatrick Haskell-Mary Sprayberry Public School Nurse
- 22 Program." It is the intent of the Legislature that all funds made
- 23 available to the State Department of Education for the purpose of
- 24 employing school nurses shall be administered by the State
- 25 Department of Education.
- 26 (2) The State Department of Education, through the Office of
- 27 Healthy Schools, shall develop standards, procedures and criteria
- 28 for the public school nurse programs in Kindergarten through Grade
- 29 12. The Office of Healthy Schools of the State Department of
- 30 Education shall assume the responsibility for promoting a
- 31 statewide school nurse program designed to prepare local school
- 32 districts to incorporate the school program into their local
- 33 educational programs.

- 34 (3) From and after July 1, 2007, the School Nurse
- 35 Intervention Program administered and funded by the State
- 36 Department of Health shall be transferred to the Office of Healthy
- 37 Schools of the State Department of Education. Any administrative
- 38 personnel employed by the State Department of Health for the
- 39 administration of school nurses under the School Nurse
- 40 Intervention Program may be considered for employment by the
- 41 Office of Healthy Schools of the State Department of Education for
- 42 the purpose of coordinating the employment of school nurses in the
- 43 school districts. Any administrative personnel formerly employed
- 44 by the Partnership for a Healthy Mississippi, Inc., for the
- 45 administration of school nurses in the public schools may be
- 46 considered for employment by the Office of Healthy Schools of the
- 47 State Department of Education for the purpose of coordinating the
- 48 employment of school nurses in the school districts. All records
- 49 and unexpended balances of accounts in the School Nurse
- 50 Intervention Program relating to the employment of school nurses
- 51 shall be transferred to the Office of Healthy Schools in the State
- 52 Department of Education in accordance with the transfer of
- 53 responsibility under this act.
- 54 (4) The nurses in the Mary Kirkpatrick Haskell-Mary
- 55 Sprayberry Public School Nurse Program shall have the following
- 56 specific responsibilities:
- 57 (a) Serve as the coordinator of the health services
- 58 program and provide nursing care;
- (b) Provide health education to students;
- 60 (c) Implement activities to promote health and prevent
- 61 tobacco, alcohol and substance use and abuse;
- 62 (d) Identify health and safety concerns in the school
- 63 environment and promote a nurturing social environment;
- (e) Administer medications and help students manage
- 65 their health problems;

- 66 Support healthy food services programs; (f)
- 67 (g)Promote healthy physical education, sports policies
- 68 and practices;
- 69 Promote dropout prevention programs; and
- 70 (i) Participate in allied health programs to introduce
- 71 students to health careers.
- The Office of Healthy Schools of the State Department of 72
- 73 Education shall provide resources to all public school nurses so
- that those schools with school nurses will be prepared to provide 74
- 75 health education in Mississippi schools and support the
- 76 Mississippi Comprehensive Health Framework, Mississippi Physical
- Education Framework, Wellness Policy, coordinated approach to 77
- 78 school health, and other resources required by the State Board of
- Education. 79
- (6) In administering the Mary Kirkpatrick Haskell-Mary 80
- 81 Sprayberry Public School Nurse Program, the Office of Healthy
- 82 Schools of the State Department of Education shall perform the
- following duties: 83
- 84 Execute any contracts, agreements or other
- 85 documents with any governmental agency or any person, corporation,
- 86 association, partnership or other organization or entity that are
- 87 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this act;
- 88 (b) Receive grants or any other contributions made to
- 89 the State Board of Education to be used for specific purposes
- related to the goals of this act; 90
- 91 Submit an annual report to the Legislature (C)
- 92 regarding the operation of the School Nurse Intervention Program;
- 93 Submit to the State Auditor any financial records (d)
- 94 that are necessary for the Auditor to perform an annual audit of
- 95 the commission as required by law;
- 96 (e) Adopt any rules or regulations that are necessary
- 97 to carry out the purposes of this act;

98	(f)	Develop	criteria	to	measure	the	effectiveness	of	а

- 100 (g)Communicate to superintendents and principals how 101 to maximize the effectiveness of a public school nurse;
- 102 Develop recommended salary structure for school 103 districts to use when hiring a school nurse;
- 104 (i) Communicate to superintendents, principals and 105 other appropriate school officials regarding the statutes and 106 regulations prohibiting the use of tobacco by school personnel on 107 school property and at school events, and to monitor the 108 effectiveness of this ban;
- (j) Report to the Senate and House Public Health and 109 110 Welfare and Education Committees' Chairmen annually on the number of public school nurses, in which schools they are employed, 111 results of their work in relation to the measures in paragraph 112 113 (f);
- Implement policies to reduce unnecessary paperwork 114 115 by public school nurses; and
- 116 Take any other actions that are necessary to carry (1)117 out the purposes of this act.
- SECTION 3. The Division of Medicaid shall cooperate with the 118 119 State Department of Education to develop and seek approval from 120 the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for a waiver 121 or grant to cover the services of public school nurses, as allowed 122 by federal law. The division is also authorized to explore other options for administering and providing services under this 123 124 program, including, but not limited to, matching any available 125 federal funds. The Department of Education shall place particular emphasis on reducing unnecessary paperwork by public school 126 127 nurses.
- SECTION 4. (1) There is established in the State Treasury a 128 129 special fund to be known as the Mary Kirkpatrick Haskell-Mary

- Sprayberry Public School Nurse Program Fund, which shall be 130
- 131 comprised of the funds specified in subsection (2) of this section
- 132 and any other funds that are authorized or required to be
- 133 deposited into the special fund.
- 134 The Legislature shall annually appropriate the funds in
- 135 the special fund to the Office of Healthy Schools of the State
- 136 Department of Education, which shall expend the funds solely for
- the purposes specified in Section 2 of this act. None of the 137
- funds in the special fund may be transferred to any other fund or 138
- 139 appropriated or expended for any other purpose.
- 140 (3) All income from the investment of the funds in the
- special fund shall be credited to the account of the special fund. 141
- 142 Any funds in the special fund at the end of a fiscal year shall
- 143 not lapse into the State General Fund.
- 144 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 145 and after July 1, 2007.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE "MARY KIRKPATRICK HASKELL-MARY SPRAYBERRY PUBLIC SCHOOL NURSE PROGRAM" TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION THROUGH THE OFFICE OF HEALTHY SCHOOLS; TO SPECIFY THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE NURSES IN THE PROGRAM; TO PRESCRIBE THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF HEALTHY SCHOOLS IN ADMINISTERING THE PROGRAM; TO ESTABLISH IN THE STATE TREASURY A SPECIAL FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE SCHOOL NURSE PROGRAM FUND; TO PROVIDE THAT THE LEGISLATURE SHALL ANNUALLY APPROPRIATE THE FUNDS IN THE SPECIAL FUND TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, WHICH SHALL EXPEND THE FUNDS SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
