We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1651: Appropriation; State Board of Medical Licensure.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 66 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 68 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 69 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 70 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 72 appropriated level.
- 73 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 74 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 75 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 76 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 77 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 78 State Board of Medical Licensure shall maintain complete
- 79 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 80 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 81 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 82 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 83 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be
- 84 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 85 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 86 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
- 87 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 90 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

- quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 91
- 92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 93
- 94 made without competitive bids.
- 95 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 96 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 97
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 98
- Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 99
- 100 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 101 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after July 1, 2007. 102

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 STATE BOARD OF MEDICAL LICENSURE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008.
