REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1659: Appropriation; Athletic Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Athletic Commission
8	Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
9	Athletic Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007,
10	and ending June 30, 2008 \$ 126,091.00.
11	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
12	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
13	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
14	Permanent: Full Time 1
15	Part Time 0
16	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
17	Part Time 0
18	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
19	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
20	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
21	Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever
22	is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
23	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
24	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
25	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
26	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008

funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 27 28 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 29 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 30 31 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 32 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 33 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 34 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal 35 36 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds 37 and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services", the State Personnel Board 38 determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause 39 40 the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 41 42 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or 43 the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this 44 45 provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 46 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance 47 report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in 48 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.

49 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 50 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 51 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 52 53 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 54 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 55 56 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 57 58 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement

(H)AP (S)AP A1/2 of a departing employee with an individual from within state service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise authorized in this act.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 67 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 69 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 70 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 71 72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 73 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

78 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 79 Mississippi Athletic Commission shall maintain complete accounting 80 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 81 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 82 83 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to 84 85 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 86 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 87

88 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that 89 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 90 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

A similar preference shall be given to 94 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 95 made without competitive bids.

96 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 97 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 98 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 99 100 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 101 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 102 103 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
