REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1678: Appropriation; Department of Transportation.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

43 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 44 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 45 46 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 47 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 48 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 49 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 50 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 51 52 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 53 act. 54 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 55 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds 56 57 and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services", the State Personnel Board 58 59 determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause

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the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 60 61 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 62 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State 63 64 Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this 65 provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 66 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in 67 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks. 68

69 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 70 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 71 72 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 73 The 74 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 75 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 76 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 77 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

82 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi 83 Department of Transportation under the provisions of Section 1 and 84 authorized for expenditure in Section 2, the following amounts 85 shall be available for expenditure in the program budgets as 86 required by Section 27-103-127, Mississippi Code of 1972:

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 94 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall maintain complete 95 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 96 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 97 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 98 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 99 100 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 101 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 102 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, it is the intention of the Legislature that Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be transferred to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce for the Beaver Control or Eradication Program during the Fiscal Year 2008.

SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall expend such funds as necessary to conduct project planning. Such project planning shall apply to all preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and construction projects of the department and, at a minimum, shall consist of policies for the oversight and management of project cost which:

(a) Establish a reasonable cost estimate for each project. For purposes of this provision, projects include preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and construction;

(b) Capture and retain the initial project cost
estimates for comparison with final actual expenditures;
(c) Require that any changes to a cost estimate for a
project will be reviewed and approved by district or central

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(d) Capture the cost of consultants, engineers,
attorneys, contract appraisers and other technical and
professional contractors used in preliminary engineering,
right-of-way acquisition and construction projects.

131 SECTION 7. None of the funds appropriated under the 132 provisions of Section 1 of this act may be expended by the 133 Department of Transportation for construction of new highways if 134 such highway segment is less than ten (10) miles in length unless:

(a) The explanation and justification for letting such
a contract for a length of less than ten (10) miles is entered
upon the official minutes of the Transportation Commission;

(b) The commission, within ten (10) working days after entry of its explanation and justification upon its minutes, gives notice, by United States First Class Mail, and provides a copy of such entry upon its minutes, to the Chairman of the Transportation Committee of the Mississippi House of Representatives and the Chairman of the Mississippi Senate Highways and Transportation Committee.

145 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated to the Mississippi 146 Department of Transportation, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars 147 (\$300,000.00) shall be used for the Statewide Litter Prevention 148 Program.

149 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 150 Mississippi Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to 151 receive, budget and expend in the Capital Outlay major object of 152 expenditure an amount not to exceed Six Million Dollars 153 (\$6,000,000.00) resulting from funds received from third party 154 damages. SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and allocated in Section 2, not less than Eighty Million Dollars (\$80,000,000.00) shall be expended for contracted maintenance overlay and pavement rehabilitation.

159 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 160 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall have the authority 161 to escalate its budget in the Capital Outlay - Other Than 162 Equipment or the Commodities major objects of expenditure in the Maintenance Program, with funds which were obligated in Fiscal 163 164 Year 2007 for maintenance overlay projects and maintenance repair 165 projects but not completed by the end of Fiscal Year 2007, in an amount not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00). Any 166 167 escalation made from the authority granted in this section shall 168 be reported to the Chairmen of the Appropriations Committees of 169 the Mississippi Senate and the Mississippi House of 170 Representatives, the Chairman of the Highways and Transportation 171 Committee of the Mississippi Senate, the Chairman of the Transportation Committee of the Mississippi House of 172 Representatives, and the Legislative Budget Office, within fifteen 173 174 (15) working days after said escalation.

SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to transfer between the various programs in an amount not to exceed ten percent (10%) of the amount allocated in Section 3, except that no transfers shall be authorized which increase the "Administrative and Other Expenses" Program or which decrease the Maintenance" Program.

SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to escalate its budget for Fiscal Year 2008 for funds appropriated in Fiscal Year 2007 but not expended in Fiscal Year 2007 by the Mississippi Department of Transportation in the "Capital

191 SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated under Section 1 of 192 this act, the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall 193 expend so much thereof as may be necessary to adjust and/or 194 relocate electric transmission lines located along and within the 195 right-of-way of the construction project designated as the 196 widening of State Route 43 from State Route 12 to Blackjack Road, 197 STP-8925-00-002 (102435-201000), all within the City of Kosciusko, 198 Attala County.

SECTION 15. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds not to exceed Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) received from other public or private entities as reimbursements for payments made on federal projects.

SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that no funds in the Treasury to the credit of the Department of Transportation shall be transferred by the Treasury Department to make payment on general obligation bond debt service obligations of the state unless such funds are to be repaid during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008.

SECTION 17. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the Mississippi Department of Transportation is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to conduct a study on monorail transportation in Tunica and Desoto Counties.

216 **SECTION 18.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none 217 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 218 of the Mississippi Senate and House of Representatives are

notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 219 220 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 221 announcement of ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening 222 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 223 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 224 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following 225 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the 226 Mississippi State Legislature."

227 SECTION 19. It is the intention of the Legislature that 228 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 229 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 230 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 231 232 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 233 234 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 20. The Department of Transportation is hereby authorized to expend available funds on technology or equipment upgrades or replacements when it will generate savings through efficiency or when the savings generated from such upgrades or replacements exceed expenditures thereof.

SECTION 21. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Department of Transportation for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008\$ 200,000.00.

248 **SECTION 22.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the 249 Mississippi Department of Transportation is authorized to expend 250 an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

SECTION 23. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Transportation shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds not to exceed Fifty-seven Million Dollars (\$57,000,000.00) received as reimbursements for payments on project costs associated with Senate Bill No. 3215 of the 2007 Regular Legislative Session.

SECTION 24. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the Mississippi Department of Transportation shall expend so much thereof as may be necessary to four-lane Highway 15 in Laurel to the Bay Springs City Limit and three-lane Highway 15 from the Bay Springs City Limit to the Industrial Park in lieu of a bypass.

SECTION 25. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) shall be used to access federal funds for costs associated with the Rails to Trails Program from Houston, Mississippi, to New Albany, Mississippi.

268 **SECTION 26.** The Mississippi Department of Transportation 269 shall transfer One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) to the Railroad 270 Revitalization Fund.

271 SECTION 27. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 272 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 273 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 274 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 275 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 276 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 277 SECTION 28. This act shall take effect and be in force from 278 and after July 1, 2007.
