- 62 expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth
- 63 by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the
- 64 State Fiscal Officer.
- 65 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 66 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 67 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 68 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 69 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 70 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 71 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 72 made without competitive bids.
- 73 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 74 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 75 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 76 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 77 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 78 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 79 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 80 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
