REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1692: Appropriation; Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of		
8	defraying the expenses of the Grand Gulf Military Monument		
9	Commission in the operation and maintenance of the Grand Gulf		
10	Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and		
11	ending June 30, 2008\$ 267,021.00.		
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special		
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Grand Gulf		
15	Military Monument Commission, for the purpose of defraying the		
16	expenses of the commission in the operation and maintenance of the		
17	Grand Gulf Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning		
18	July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008 \$ 86,902.00.		
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
20	Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:		
21	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:		
22	Permanent: Full Time 7		
23	Part Time 2		
24	Time-Limited: Full Time

26 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 27 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 28 equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever 29 30 is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007. 31 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 32 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 34 35 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 36 37 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 38 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 39 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 40 41 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 42 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal 43 44 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds 45 and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services", the State Personnel Board 46 47 determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause 48 the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 49 50 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or 51 the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State 52 Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 53 54 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance 55 report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in order for agencies to award educational benchmarks. 56

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 57 58 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 59 60 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 61 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 62 63 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 64 appropriated level. 65 66 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 67 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 68 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 69 70 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 71 Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission shall maintain complete 72 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 73 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 74 75 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 76 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 77 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 78 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 79 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 80 It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 81 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 82 83 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 84 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof. 85 86 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 87

with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

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89	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that	
90	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the	
91	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things	
92	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,	
93	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind	
94	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to	
95	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are	
96	made without competitive bids.	
97	SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by	

98 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 99 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 100 101 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 102 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

103 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2007. 104

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
