## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MR. SPEAKER AND MADAM PRESIDENT:

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We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1705: Appropriation; State Fire Academy.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be				
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State				
6	Treasury to the credit of the State Fire Academy Fund, for the				
7	purpose of defraying the expenses of the academy for the fiscal				
8	year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008

10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of				
11	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be				
12	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

- 59 provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board
- 60 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance
- 61 report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in
- 62 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 65 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 66 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 67 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 68 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 69 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 70 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 71 appropriated level.
- 72 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 73 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 74 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 75 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 76 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 77 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and
- 78 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 79 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 80 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 81 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 82 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to
- 83 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 84 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 85 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
- 86 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 87 State Fire Academy shall have the authority to escalate and expend
- 88 funds, not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
- 89 (\$150,000.00), from any source that may become available to the

- 90 agency in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
- 91 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
- 92 with the escalation of federal funds.
- 93 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 94 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 95 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 96 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 97 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 98 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 99 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 100 made without competitive bids.
- 101 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 102 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 103 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 104 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 105 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 106 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 107 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 108 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
