## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

- S. B. No. 3117: Appropriation; Governor's Office and Mansion.
  - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
  - That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
  - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that 62
- 63 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 64 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 65 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 66
- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 67
- 68 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- made without competitive bids. 69
- SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 70
- 71 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 72
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 73
- 74 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 75 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from 76
- 77 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENSES OF THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT, BEING THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND STAFF, AND FOR 2 3 EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE PROPER OPERATION OF THE GOVERNOR'S MANSION AND RESIDENCE OF THE GOVERNOR, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008.
