## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

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We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3130: Appropriation; Jr. Colleges - Admin.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- 1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of		
8	defraying the administrative expenses of the State Board for		
9	Community and Junior Colleges for the fiscal year beginning		
10	July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008 \$ 7,169,142.00.		
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
13	Treasury to the credit of the State Board for Community and Junior		
14	Colleges, for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses		
15	of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the		
16	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008		
17	\$ 79,123,799.00.		
18	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
19	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State		
20	Treasury to the credit of the Commission on Proprietary School and		
21	College Registration, for the purpose of defraying the expenses		
22	incurred in the regulation and administration of the Mississippi		
23	Proprietary School and College Registration Law and the associated		
24	expenses of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for		
25	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008

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27 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 28 Sections 1, 2, and 3, the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 29 30 Permanent: Full Time..... 41 31 Part Time..... 0 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 32 1 Part Time..... 33 34 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 35 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 36 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 37 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 38 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 39 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 40 budget requests of the administrative expenses of the State Board 41 42 for Community and Junior Colleges for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 43 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 44 45 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 46 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated herein, One Million 47 Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall be expended from the Work Force 48 Carryover Fund as created by House Bill No. 1271, 1995 Regular 49 Session. 50 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 51 funds in the amount of Forty Million Nine Hundred Nineteen Thousand One Hundred Ninety-four Dollars (\$40,919,194.00) are 52 53 appropriated for the Workforce Education Program and Industrial 54 Training. Of these funds Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) is appropriated to implement a pilot program that 55 56 promotes workplace readiness using a nationally accepted assessment and granting career readiness certificates using 57 58 KeyTrain and WorkKeys Job Skills Assessment System. No funding

- obligation or commitment shall be made on behalf of the state for 59
- 60 industrial training beyond the level of funding made available in
- 61 this section. All industrial training program commitments made in
- 62 Fiscal Year 2008 and future fiscal years shall be based only upon
- 63 funds available in this section and any proposed commitments shall
- 64 be approved by the Executive Director of the State Board for
- 65 Community and Junior Colleges, or the Executive Director's
- 66 designee prior to such commitment being finalized. Industrial
- training program commitments shall be made and based only upon 67
- 68 training services provided and not for a specific funding amount.
- Any expenditures of funds authorized in this section are limited 69
- to obligations made July 1, 2007, or after, and shall not be 70
- expended for obligations made prior to this date. 71
- SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds in 72
- the amount of Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) shall 73
- 74 be derived from unemployment compensation contributions deposited
- 75 into the Mississippi Workforce Enhancement Training Fund and shall
- 76 be utilized exclusively by the State Board for Community and
- 77 Junior Colleges for workforce training in accordance with Senate
- 78 Bill 2480, 2005 Regular Session. It is the intention of the
- 79 Legislature that the Workforce Enhancement Training Fund shall
- 80 have not less than Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) set aside
- 81 as a carry-forward to begin the Fiscal Year 2009 Workforce
- 82 Education Program.
- 83 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds in
- the amount of Nine Hundred Nineteen Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-84
- 85 eight Dollars (\$919,998.00) shall be derived from fees charged for
- the Community College Network, Workforce On-line Training Program 86
- and the Mississippi Virtual Community College and funds in the 87
- 88 amount of Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
- (\$3,500,000.00) shall be transferred from the Community and Junior 89
- 90 College Education Technology fund for the purpose of defraying the

- 91 costs of the Mississippi Virtual Community College, the Workforce
- 92 On-line Training Program and the administrative expenses of the
- 93 State Board for Community and Junior Colleges.
- 94 **SECTION 10.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- 95 of Section 2, funds in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 96 (\$100,000.00) shall be derived from fees charged for issuing
- 97 duplicate transcripts and duplicate diplomas for the General
- 98 Education Development (GED) Testing Program for the purpose of
- 99 defraying the costs of administering the GED Testing Program of
- 100 the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges, in accordance
- 101 with Senate Bill No. 2626, 2002 Regular Session.
- 102 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 103 State Board of Community and Junior Colleges is hereby authorized
- 104 to accept, budget and expend funds from any source in an amount
- 105 not to exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) in accordance
- 106 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 107 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 108 federal funds.
- 109 **SECTION 12.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds in
- 110 the amount of Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00) shall be
- 111 derived from the transfer of post-secondary vocational and
- 112 technical funds from the Mississippi Department of Education to
- 113 the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the purpose
- 114 of managing the day-to-day operations of post-secondary vocational
- 115 and technical education.
- 116 SECTION 13. Of the funds provided in Section 2, not more
- 117 than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used for
- 118 a pilot project to implement dual enrollment opportunities in
- 119 practical nursing programs for secondary students.
- 120 **SECTION 14.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Five
- 121 Hundred Forty-eight Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-two Dollars
- 122 (\$548,492.00) is provided to the State Board for Community and

- Junior Colleges for the purpose of defraying the cost of the 123
- 124 Greenville Higher Education Center.
- SECTION 15. It is the intention of the Legislature that 125
- 126 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 127 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 128 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 129 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 130
- the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 131
- 132 made without competitive bids.
- 133 SECTION 16. It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial
- 134 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further,
- 135 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for
- this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner. 136
- Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe 137
- 138 the following criteria:
- 139 Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.
- 140 (2) Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising
- 141 standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness.
- 142 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired
- 143 by media without cost.
- 144 Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
- 145 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
- 146 media expenditures.
- 147 (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible.
- 148 SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that an
- 149 amount equal to One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per square foot
- shall be paid to the Executive Office of the State Board of 150
- Institutions of Higher Learning to defray utility costs. 151
- 152 SECTION 18. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 153
- 154 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 155 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 156 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 157 SECTION 19. This act shall take effect and be in force from 158 159 and after July 1, 2007.

## Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
