REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3132: Appropriation; Gaming Commission.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

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It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 59 act. 60 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 61 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal 62 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds 63 and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any 64 action to change "Personal Services", the State Personnel Board 65 determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause 66 the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 67 68 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or 69 the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this 70 provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 71 72 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in 73 74 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.

75 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 76 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 77 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 78 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 79 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 80 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 81 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 82 83 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

88 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One 89 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be 90 transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a 91 nonprofit organization.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 92 93 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 94 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 95 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 96 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 97 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 98 99 made without competitive bids.

100 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 101 Mississippi Gaming Commission shall have the authority to escalate 102 and expend funds from any proceeds arising from the participation 103 in seizures of illegal gaming activities not to exceed One Hundred 104 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00).

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2007.
