REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3137: Appropriation; Agriculture & Commerce - Support and Grain Div.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Agriculture and
9	Commerce, including the Divisions of Support, Plant Industry and
10	Farmers Central Market, for the fiscal year beginning
11	July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008 \$ 8,883,248.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
14	source funds, which are collected by or otherwise become available
15	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Department
16	of Agriculture and Commerce, including the Divisions of Support
17	and Plant Industry and Farmers Central Market, for the fiscal year
18	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
19	\$ 5,910,185.00.
20	The funds authorized for expenditure under the provisions of
21	this section include subscription fees produced from the Market
22	Bulletin and admission fees produced from the Mississippi
23	Agriculture and Forestry Museum.
24	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
25	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 26 27 Permanent: Full Time..... 223 28 Part Time..... 2 29 Time-Limited: Full Time...... 19 30 Part Time..... 0 31 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 32 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation 33 Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever 34 35 is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007. 36 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 39 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 40 41 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 42 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 43 44 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 46 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 47 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 48 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds 49 50 and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services", the State Personnel Board 51 52 determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 53 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then 54 55 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State 56 57 Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this

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- provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 58
- 59 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance
- 60 report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in
- order for agencies to award educational benchmarks. 61
- 62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 63 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 64 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 65 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 66
- 67 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 68
- 69 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 70 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 71
- used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 72
- 73 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 74 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 75 SECTION 4. The funds appropriated and authorized to be
- 76 expended under the provisions of this act shall be expended for
- 77 the purpose of defraying all expenses incurred by the State
- 78 Department of Agriculture and Commerce in the operation of all
- 79 programs and activities (except operation of the State Lime
- 80 Plants, Veterinary Laboratory, Pink Bollworm-Plant Quarantine
- Inspection Stations and Fire Ant Program) authorized to be 81
- 82 conducted and carried on by said department; including, but not
- limited to: the administration of the Feed, Fertilizer and Dairy 83
- 84 Act; the Weights and Measure Act; the Meat Inspection Act of 1968;
- the Mississippi Pure Seed Law; and the following additional 85
- programs and activities: enforcement of the egg law; publication 86
- 87 and distribution of the Mississippi Market Bulletin, agricultural
- 88 statistics, market news service at Stoneville, Mississippi; and
- 89 inspection, grading and certifying of fruits, vegetables, hay,

91	seed and syrup.
92	SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Agriculture and
93	Commerce, with the assistance of the State Department of Audit and
94	the Department of Finance and Administration, shall establish
95	nonbudgeted enterprise funds for all "for profit" activities
96	related to the Mississippi Agriculture and Forestry Museum. The
97	funds shall be maintained in accordance with generally accepted
98	accounting principles and regulations prescribed by the Department
99	of Finance and Administration.
100	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
101	State Department of Agriculture and Commerce is hereby authorized
102	to accept, budget and expend funds from any source in accordance
103	with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
104	Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
105	federal funds.
106	SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
107	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
108	Treasury to the credit of the Beaver Control Program or from any
109	other special source funds made available to the Beaver Control
110	Program, to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce for the
111	support of the Beaver Control Program for the fiscal year
112	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
113	\$ 700,000.00.
114	Of the special funds authorized in this section, Two Hundred
115	Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be derived from funds
116	received from the Mississippi Department of Transportation and Two
117	Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be derived from
118	counties and from fees charged private persons/organizations, and
119	Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be derived from
120	funds received from the State Forestry Commission.

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- 121 SECTION 8. Of the funds provided by the provisions of this 122 act, it is the intent of the Legislature that not more than Thirty 123 Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) shall be expended for the 124 Mississippi Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Pilot Program, which 125 shall be established by the State Department of Agriculture and 126 Commerce to serve senior citizens above sixty (60) years of age 127 who fall within one hundred thirty percent (130%) of the poverty level. The Commissioner of Agriculture may promulgate rules and 128 129 regulations necessary to implement the Mississippi Senior Farmers' 130 Market Nutrition Pilot Program. SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated herein, not more than 131 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) is provided, for the 132 133
- purpose of making incentive payments to producers of ethanol 134 utilizing Mississippi-produced agriculture commodities under the provisions of Section 69-51-5, Mississippi Code of 1972. 135
- 136 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 137 State Department of Agriculture and Commerce shall have the 138 authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from peanut 139 revenue not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) 140 in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of 141 Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 142
- 143 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that 144 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 145 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 146 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 147 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 148 149 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 150 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 12. It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial 151 152 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further,

- it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for 153
- 154 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner.
- 155 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe
- 156 the following criteria:
- 157 Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.
- 158 Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising
- standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness. 159
- 160 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired
- 161 by media without cost.
- 162 Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
- 163 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
- 164 media expenditures.
- 165 (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible.
- 166 SECTION 13. Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- 167 this act, Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) shall be provided
- 168 to the Fair Commission County Livestock Shows for prize money.
- 169 SECTION 14. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 170
- 171 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 172 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 173 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 174 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 175 SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 176 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND COMMERCE, 2 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2008.
