REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3140: Appropriation; Fair Comm. - Dixie Natl Livestock Show.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

The following sums, or so much thereof as may be 38 necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Fair 39 Commission as follows: 40 41 (a) For the support of annual roundup shows for junior exhibitors of junior steers, junior breeding cattle, beef cattle, 42 43 dairy cattle, hogs, sheep and goats, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 44 45\$ 69,720.00. (b) To supplement the funds paid by the Mississippi 46 47 Fair Commission for livestock premiums at the State Fair, all 48 livestock premiums to be paid on the American system of judging (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, etc.) on all classes entered in the senior 49 50 division for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 51 June 30, 2008..... \$ 26,997.00. 52 (c) For the county livestock shows in offering and 53 paying prizes or awards to competitors in the approved county 54 livestock shows of Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... \$ 13,138.00. 55 56 Provided, however, that of the amount herein appropriated in subsection (c), not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) 57 58 shall be expended or used in any one county of the state during 59 each fiscal year. Provided, further, that none of the monies herein appropriated in subsection (c) shall be used in offering or 60 61 paying prizes or awards for any livestock show that is not held where there are adequate barns, pens and other facilities 62 63 available for such a show.

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Provided, further, in subsection (c) that the management of 64 65 such shows shall be in the hands of a county livestock association, and such association shall guarantee a minimum amount 66 67 of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be used in the paying of 68 prizes, premiums or awards, and after said county show has been 69 held and premiums paid, fifty percent (50%) of the amount, not 70 exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), shall be paid upon 71 requisition to the Mississippi Fair Commission.

Provided, further, in subsection (c) that in any county which has two (2) shows with proper facilities, and a contiguous county has no such fair and desires to participate in a fair to be held in an adjoining county, each of the two (2) fairs in one (1) county may receive an equal proportion of the funds hereby appropriated, provided, both shows shall not receive an aggregate sum of more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

(d) For the purpose of offering awards and prizes to competitors in the five (5) district livestock shows, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 2008.....

(e) For the purpose of offering awards and prizes to
competitors in the five (5) state dairy shows as provided in
Section 69-5-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal
year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008.....

88 Provided, further, that no part of the money herein appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall 89 90 be used for any other purpose than to pay premium awards at said 91 shows and state shows and expositions receiving legislative appropriation shall not conflict in dates in order that livestock 92 93 exhibitors may make the circuit of shows. Provided, further, that none of the above mentioned funds shall be paid to any district 94 95 shows unless shows are held prior to roundup.

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96 Not less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the funds herein 97 appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall 98 be used in awarding prizes or premiums to 4-H Club members and 99 Smith-Hughes School members and other boys and girls having 100 entries in said shows.

101 All funds herein appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) for the five (5) district livestock shows 102 and the five (5) fall state dairy shows shall be distributed in 103 104 such manner that the livestock exhibitors will each draw equal 105 premium awards for comparable grades and placings at each of the 106 said five (5) district spring shows and the five (5) fall state shows. The management of each district spring show and each state 107 108 fall show shall submit to the Mississippi Fair Commission, within 109 fifteen (15) days after the close of each said show, a full report 110 on the number of exhibitors at each said show, with the grades and 111 placings of the different classes of livestock exhibited.

112 The Executive Secretary of the Mississippi Fair Commission, together with a committee of three (3) to be named by the 113 114 President of the Mississippi Livestock Council from that 115 organization, shall summarize and prepare a unified list of awards 116 for like classes in all spring district livestock shows and fall 117 state dairy shows receiving state premium money, as authorized in 118 subsections (d) and (e). The Executive Secretary and Chairman of 119 the Mississippi Fair Commission shall approve and present a requisition to the State Fiscal Officer for the payment of the 120 121 amount of funds in subsections (d) and (e) due each show and said 122 State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrant thereon, and it shall 123 be paid by the State Treasurer.

Provided, however, as a condition of expenditure of the funds appropriated in subsections (d) and (e), that the board of directors of any district livestock show may, in its discretion, choose to hold its show in the fall instead of the spring. If

It is the intention of the Legislature that 154 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 155 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 156 157 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

158 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

159 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 160 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 6. It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further, it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner. Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe the following criteria:

167 (1) Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.

168 (2) Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising169 standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness.

170 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired171 by media without cost.

172 (4) Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
173 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
174 media expenditures.

175 (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible. 176 **SECTION 7.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 177 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 178 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 179 180 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 181 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 182 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 183 and after July 1, 2007.
