## REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

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We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

- S. B. No. 3141: Appropriation; Fair and Coliseum Comm. Support.
  - We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:
  - That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
  - 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
7	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
8	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission
9	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said Mississippi Fair
10	Commission, the Mississippi Livestock Coliseum, the Industrial
11	Showcase, the Trade Mart Building and for the purpose of paying
12	any indebtedness which may accrue for the period beginning
13	July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008 \$ 4,627,221.00.
14	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
15	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
16	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
17	expenditure:
18	MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE:

36	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
37	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
38	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
39	Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever
40	is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
41	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
42	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
43	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
44	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
45	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
46	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
47	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
48	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
49	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
50	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
51	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
52	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
53	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal
54	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds
55	and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any
56	action to change "Personal Services", the State Personnel Board
57	determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause
58	the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year
59	2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then

- 60 only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or
- 61 the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State
- 62 Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this
- provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 63
- 64 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance
- report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in 65
- 66 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 67
- the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 68
- 69 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 70 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 71 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 72 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 73 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 74 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 75 appropriated level.
- 76 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 77 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 78 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 79 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 80 SECTION 3. No operation, maintenance or service contracts,
- 81 agreements or obligations for commodities, concessions, or
- 82 catering services, shall be entered into or renewed by this agency
- for a period of more than three (3) years nor unless said 83
- 84 contracts, agreements or obligations have been made in accordance
- with Sections 31-7-11, 31-7-13, 31-7-55 and 31-7-57, Mississippi 85
- Code of 1972. 86
- 87 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 90
- 91 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

- 92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 93 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 94 made without competitive bids.
- 95 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and
- 96 authorized for expenditure in Section 2, it is the intention of
- 97 the Legislature that Twenty-two Thousand Dollars (\$22,000.00)
- 98 shall be transferred to the Fair Commission County Livestock
- 99 Shows, and for the following allocation: Twelve Thousand Dollars
- 100 (\$12,000.00) is provided for Traditional Groom Shows and Ten
- 101 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) is provided for NCHA Eastern
- 102 National Championships.
- 103 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 104 Mississippi Fair Commission shall have the authority to escalate
- 105 its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed One
- 106 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) in
- 107 accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance
- 108 and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 109 federal funds.
- 110 **SECTION 7.** It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial
- 111 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further,
- 112 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for
- 113 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner.
- 114 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe
- 115 the following criteria:
- 116 (1) Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.
- 117 (2) Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising
- 118 standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness.
- 119 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired
- 120 by media without cost.
- 121 (4) Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
- 122 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
- 123 media expenditures.

(5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible. 124 125 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 126 127 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 128 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 129 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 130 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 131 and after July 1, 2007, except for Section 6 which shall take 132 133 effect and be in force from and after passage.

## Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE 1 EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI FAIR COMMISSION, THE MISSISSIPPI 2 3 LIVESTOCK COLISEUM AND THE INDUSTRIAL SHOWCASE AND TRADE MART BUILDING FOR FISCAL YEARS 2007 AND 2008.
