## **REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE**

## MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3154: Appropriation; Employment Security Comm.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

38 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 40 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 41 42 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 43 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 44 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 45 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 47 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 49 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriations for "Personal 50 51 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds and educational benchmarks. If, at the time the agency takes any 52 action to change "Personal Services", the State Personnel Board 53 determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause 54 the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 55 56 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or 57 58 the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State

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Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this 59 60 provision are met. On January 1, 2008, the State Personnel Board 61 will make adjustments to the structure side of the compliance 62 report based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office in 63 order for agencies to award educational benchmarks.

64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 66 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 67 68 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 69 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 70 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 72 appropriated level.

73 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 74 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 75 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 76

77 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 78 Section 1, the following sum shall be derived from money in the 79 Unemployment Trust Fund, made available to this state under 80 Section 903(d) of the Social Security Act, as amended, to the 81 Mississippi Employment Security Commission to be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund and used by the 82 83 Mississippi Employment Security Commission for the following purposes: 84

85 1. Payment of various One-Stop Administration expenses that support the service delivery of employment and workforce 86 information services. This includes, but is not limited to, the 87 88 following activities:

Staff for delivery of reemployment services to UI a.

90 claimants, including group job search assistance and staff-assisted referrals to jobs. 91 Equipment and resources for resource rooms. 92 b. 93 Payment for rent, utilities, and maintenance of с. 94 facilities, including common spaces such as 95 resource rooms, reception areas, conference areas, 96 etc. 97 d. Payment of shared costs for operation of local One-Stop Career Centers, including payment for One-98 99 Stop operators. 100 Purchase of computer equipment, network equipment, e. telecommunications equipment, application 101 102 development, and other technology resources. 103 f. Training, technical assistance, and professional 104 development of staff who deliver employment and workforce information services. 105 106 q. Access Improvement costs for individuals with 107 disabilities, including remodeling or retrofitting 108 One-Stop Career Centers and purchasing appropriate 109 software, hardware, furniture and supplies. Administration of the Unemployment Compensation (UC) law 110 2. 111 and its public employment service (ES) offices. This includes, 112 but is not limited to, the following uses: 113 ES and UI automation. This includes purchases, а. 114 modifications, or automation of computer related 115 systems and related costs. 116 b. UI and ES Performance Improvement costs. Fraud and Abuse Reduction costs. 117 с. UI Claims Filing and Payment Methods Improvement 118 d. 119 costs.

Under the direction of the Office of Building, 120 e. 121 Grounds and Real Property Management to acquire 122 lands and construct buildings thereon or improve 123 existing buildings to be used as offices. 124 The funds in this section are authorized for the fiscal year 125 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 126 .....\$ 53,000,000.00. The funds authorized in this Section shall be requisitioned 127 128 by the Mississippi Employment Security Commission from the 129 Unemployment Trust Fund maintained by the Secretary of the 130 Treasury of the United States as needed for the payment of obligations incurred under this appropriation, and such monies 131 132 shall be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 71-5-457, Mississippi 133 134 Code of 1972.

135 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in this act, a total of 136 One Million Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$1,035,000.00) is provided for the purpose of constructing and/or lease purchasing a 137 138 new headquarters facility for the Mississippi Employment Security 139 Commission, and paying for any costs associated with the construction of facilities. The funds authorized in this section 140 141 shall be under the direction of the Bureau of Building, Grounds 142 and Real Property Management.

143 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 144 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 145 146 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 147 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 148 149 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 150 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 151 152 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 153 154 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 155 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 156 157 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

158 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
