REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

MADAM PRESIDENT AND MR. SPEAKER:

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3164: Appropriation; Veterinary Exam. Bd.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. That the following sum, or so much thereof as may 5
- be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 6
- 7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of
- 8 Veterinary Examiners for the purpose of defraying the expenses
- 9 incurred by said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007,
- and ending June 30, 2008.....\$ 10 120,810.00.
- 11 SECTION 2. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in
- 12 accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established
- 13 by law.
- 14 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 15 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 16
- act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 17
- SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 18
- Veterinary Examiners Board shall maintain complete accounting and 19
- 20 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 21
- same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 22
- 23 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to 2.4
- the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 25

- 26 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 27 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
- 28 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 29 Mississippi State Board of Veterinary Examiners shall have the
- 30 authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source
- 31 not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) in
- 32 accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance
- 33 and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- federal funds. 34
- 35 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 36
- 37 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 38
- 39 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 40
- 41 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 42 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 43
- 44 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 45 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 46
- 47 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 48
- SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 49
- 50 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
