We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

S. B. No. 3165: Appropriation; MS Workers Compensation Comm.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

- That the House recede from its Amendment No. 1.
- 2. That the Senate and House adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 66 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 68 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 69 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 70 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 72 appropriated level.
- 73 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 74 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 75 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 76 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 77 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that with
- 78 the funds appropriated in Section 1 and authorized for expenditure
- 79 in Section 2, the Mississippi Workers' Compensation Commission
- 80 shall enter into a contract with the industrial private sector for
- 81 the purpose of implementing a safety education and training
- 82 program.
- 83 **SECTION 4.** With the funds provided herein, it is the intent
- 84 of the Legislature that the Workers' Compensation Commission may
- 85 transfer a sum or sums not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
- 86 (\$200,000.00) from the Administrative Expense Fund to the Second
- 87 Injury Fund.
- 88 **SECTION 5.** With the funds provided herein, it is the intent
- 89 of the Legislature that the Workers' Compensation Commission may
- 90 transfer a sum or sums not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand

- Dollars (\$150,000.00) from the Administrative Expense Fund to the 91
- 92 Insurance Integrity Enforcement Bureau within the Office of the
- 93 Attorney General.
- 94 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 95 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 96 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 97
- quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 98
- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 99
- 100 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 101 made without competitive bids.
- SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 102
- 103 salary of the Workers' Compensation Commission members shall be
- 104 equal and the salary of the Commission Chairman shall exceed these
- 105 salaries as approved by the State Personnel Board.
- 106 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 107 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 108
- 109 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 110 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 111 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 112 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 113 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
