## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2644

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## **AMENDMENT NO. 1**

S. B. 2644 PAGE 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8	SECTION 1. Section 25-15-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9	amended as follows:
10	25-15-303. (1) There is created the State and School
11	Employees Health Insurance Management Board, which shall
12	administer the State and School Employees Life and Health
13	Insurance Plan provided for under Section 25-15-3 et seq. The
14	State and School Employees Health Insurance Management Board,
15	hereafter referred to as the "board," shall also be responsible
16	for administering all procedures for selecting third-party
17	administrators provided for in Section 25-15-301.
18	(2) The board shall consist of the following:
19	(a) The Chairman of the Workers' Compensation
20	Commission;
21	(b) The State Personnel Director;
22	(c) The Commissioner of Insurance;
23	(d) The Commissioner of Higher Education;
24	(e) The State Superintendent of Public Education;
25	(f) The Executive Director of the Department of Finance
26	and Administration;
27	(g) The Executive Director of the State Board for
28	Community and Junior Colleges;
29	(h) The Executive Director of the Public Employees'
30	Retirement System;
31	(i) Two (2) appointees of the Governor whose terms
32	shall be concurrent with that of the Governor, one (1) of whom

shall have experience in providing actuarial advice to companies

- that provide health insurance to large groups and one (1) of whom 34
- 35 shall have experience in the day-to-day management and
- administration of a large self-funded health insurance group; 36
- 37 The Chairman of the Senate Insurance Committee, or (j)
- his designee; 38
- The Chairman of the House of Representatives 39 (k)
- Insurance Committee, or his designee; 40
- 41 (1) The Chairman of the Senate Appropriations
- 42 Committee, or his designee; and
- (m) The Chairman of the House of Representatives 43
- 44 Appropriations Committee, or his designee.
- The legislators, or their designees, shall serve as ex 45
- 46 officio, nonvoting members of the board.
- The Executive Director of the Department of Finance and 47
- 48 Administration shall be the chairman of the board.
- The board shall meet at least monthly and maintain 49
- 50 minutes of the meetings. A quorum shall consist of a majority of
- 51 the authorized voting membership of the board. The board shall
- 52 have the sole authority to promulgate rules and regulations
- governing the operations of the insurance plans and shall be 53
- 54 vested with all legal authority necessary and proper to perform
- this function including, but not limited to: 55
- 56 (a) Defining the scope and coverages provided by the
- 57 insurance plan;
- 58 Seeking proposals for services or insurance through
- 59 competitive processes where required by law and selecting service
- providers or insurers under procedures provided for by law; and 60
- 61 (c) Developing and adopting strategic plans and budgets
- 62 for the insurance plan.
- 63 The department shall employ a State Insurance Administrator,
- who shall be responsible for the day-to-day management and 64
- administration of the insurance plan. The board shall employ a 65
- Deputy State Insurance Administrator who shall be an actuary and a 66
- 67 member of the American Academy of Actuaries. The Deputy State
- 68 Insurance Administrator shall have experience in providing

69 actuarial services to companies that provide health insurance to

70 large groups. The deputy administrator shall receive a salary set

71 by the board and shall not be subject to the authority of the

72 State Personnel Board for any purpose. The Department of Finance

73 and Administration shall provide to the board on a full-time basis

74 personnel and technical support necessary and sufficient to

75 effectively and efficiently carry out the requirements of this

76 section.

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77 (4) Members of the board shall not receive any compensation

78 or per diem, but may receive travel reimbursement provided for

under Section 25-3-41 except that the legislators shall receive

80 per diem and expenses, which shall be paid from the contingent

81 expense funds of their respective houses in the same amounts as

provided for committee meetings when the Legislature is not in

83 session; however, no per diem and expenses for attending meetings

84 of the board shall be paid while the Legislature is in session.

85 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

86 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 DIRECTOR OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND FOR
