THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 1 AMEND on line 25 by inserting the following language after
- 2 the word "with": "or without"
- 3 **AMEND FURTHER** on line 56 by deleting the language beginning
- 4 with the word "at" through the word "session" on line 57.
- 5 AMEND FURTHER by deleting Section 6 in its entirety and by
- 6 inserting the following language in lieu thereof:
- 7 "SECTION 6. This act shall not apply to a municipality if
- 8 the municipality employs five (5) or less full-time law
- 9 enforcement sworn officers."
- 10 **AMEND FURTHER** by adding the following language after line 62
- 11 and by renumbering the succeeding section:
- "SECTION 8. This act shall not apply to any municipality
- 13 that has a civil service commission, or has an ordinance or
- 14 written procedures regarding due process rights."
- 15 AMEND FURTHER the title by striking it in its entirety and
- 16 inserting the following in lieu thereof:
- 17 "AN ACT TO REQUIRE MUNICIPALITIES TO PROVIDE A
- 18 PRE-DISCIPLINARY HEARING PRIOR TO THE SUSPENSION OR TERMINATION OF
- 19 ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER; TO ESTABLISH A MINIMUM LEVEL OF
- 20 WRITTEN DUE PROCESS PROCEDURES; TO SPECIFY WHAT NOTICE SHALL BE
- 21 PROVIDED TO THE OFFICER; TO PROVIDE THAT THE OFFICER MAY ATTEND
- 22 THE HEARING, MAY BE REPRESENTED BY COUNSEL, MAY PRESENT EVIDENCE
- 23 ON HIS OR HER OWN BEHALF, AND MAY QUESTION WITNESSES AGAINST HIM
- 24 OR HER; TO PROVIDE THAT FINAL ADJUDICATION SHALL BE HELD IN OPEN
- 25 MEETING; TO EXEMPT MUNICIPALITIES THAT HAVE A CIVIL SERVICE

- COMMISSION OR THAT EMPLOY LESS THAN FIVE FULL-TIME LAW ENFORCEMENT 26
- 27 OFFICERS FROM THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES."
