## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2829

## TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 5
- 23-15-3, Mississippi Code of 1972: 6
- 23-15-3. For purposes of this chapter, the term "ballot box" 7
- includes any "ballot bag" used to carry ballots to and from a 8
- 9 polling place, is distributed by an election commissioner to a
- voting precinct, is delivered to the circuit clerk for 10
- preservation after an election, that encloses blank ballot 11
- 12 receipts, in which ballot cards and absentee ballot envelopes are
- deposited, inspected before an election, and any "ballot bag" used 13
- for any other purpose for which a "ballot box" may be used under 14
- the provisions of law regulating elections in Mississippi. 15
- 16 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, 17
- 18 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 19
- District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 2.0
- provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 21
- 22 extended.
- 23 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after the date it is effectuate under Section 5 of the Voting 24
- 25 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE TERM "BALLOT BOX" INCLUDES ANY
