House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3048

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

17	SECTION 1. (1) Acting on behalf of the Department of
18	Finance and Administration, the Mississippi Development Authority
19	subject to the provisions of subsection (6) and the approval of
20	the Secretary of State, is authorized to lease for a period not to
21	exceed sixty (60) years with an option to renew not to exceed
22	twenty (20) years all of the land, formerly known as the "Old
23	School for the Blind," located north of Eastover Drive in the City
24	of Jackson, Hinds County, Mississippi, and more particularly
25	described as follows:
26	Starting at a concrete monument that is the SE corner of
27	the SW $1/4$ of the SW $1/4$ of Section 24, T6N, R1E in the
28	First Judicial District, Hinds County, Mississippi, run
29	thence N 00°-01' E along the line between the E $1/2$ and
30	the W $1/2$ of the SW $1/4$ of Section 24, T6N, R1E for a
31	distance of 194.40 feet to a point on the north line of
32	Eastover Drive, as said drive is now laid out and
33	improved, the point of beginning.
34	Run thence N 56°-46' W along said north line of said
35	Eastover Drive for a distance of 3.02 feet to the P.C.
36	of a curve to the left with a radius (chord) of 5769.65
37	feet (angle of curve was omitted, 04°-00'-0r"); Run
38	thence along said curve and said north line of Eastover
39	Drive for a distance of 402.91 feet to the P.T. of said
40	curve; Run thence N 60°-46' W along said north line of
41	said Eastover Drive for a distance of 684.92 feet to a
42	point on the east right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No.

51, as said highway is now laid out and improved, Run 43 thence N 29°-14' E along said east right-of-way line of 44 U.S. Highway No. 51 for a distance of 1422.24 feet to a 45 point; Run thence N 87°-06' E for a distance of 251.28 46 feet to a point on the line between the E 1/2 and the W 47 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 24, T6N, R1E, and also 48 being a point on the south line of share 1 of the Mosal 49 partition; Run thence S 00°-01' W along said line 50 51 between the E 1/2 and the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 24, T6N, R1E for a distance of 1796.17 feet to the point 52 of beginning. 53 All the above described land being situated in the W 1/254 of the SW 1/4 of Section 24, T6N, R1E in the First 55 56

- Judicial District of Hinds County, Mississippi, and being wholly within the corporate limits of the City of Jackson and containing 22.822 acres.
- 59 (a) The property described in subsection (1) shall be leased for private redevelopment to result in the highest and best 60 use as determined by the Mississippi Development Authority and to 61 ensure that the property is used in a manner as approved by the 62 State Board of Education that will not interfere with the 63 64 operation of the Mississippi School for the Blind or the Mississippi School for the Deaf. The Mississippi Development 65 66 Authority is authorized to negotiate all aspects of the lease, and final execution of the lease shall be subject to the approval of 67 68 the Secretary of State.
- It is the intent of the Legislature that such 69 70 property will be leased to a private developer for the benefit of 71 creating value while also preserving the local environment, 72 promoting growth in the area and generating a constant revenue 73 stream for the State of Mississippi.
- 74 The Mississippi Development Authority is authorized (C) 75 to make such terms and agreements as may be reasonably necessary 76 to effect such intent to ensure a fair and equitable return to the 77 state, and the lease shall contain a provision requiring that the

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- 78 lessee construct a new residence for the Superintendent of the
- 79 Mississippi School for the Blind and a new storage and building
- maintenance facility on the grounds of the new campus for the 80
- 81 school.
- The lessee of the property shall be allowed to 82
- 83 sublease all or a portion of such property under the terms and
- conditions agreed to by the Mississippi Development Authority. 84
- 85 (3) All lease and rental monies from the lease authorized in
- 86 this section shall be deposited into a special fund, which is
- 87 created in the State Treasury. Monies in the special fund shall
- be disbursed by the Department of Finance and Administration, to 88
- the State Board of Education, for the \underline{sole} benefit of the 89
- 90 Mississippi School for the Blind and the Mississippi School for
- the Deaf. Unexpended amounts remaining in the special fund at the 91
- 92 end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund,
- and any interest earned on amounts in the special fund shall be 93
- 94 deposited to the credit of the special fund.
- 95 (4) Oil, gas and mineral rights in the property shall be
- 96 reserved to the State of Mississippi, and no provision of the
- 97 lease may provide otherwise.
- 98 Nothing in this section shall be construed to authorize
- 99 the sale or transfer of title to the property described in
- 100 subsection (1).
- 101 There is created an advisory committee to the
- 102 Mississippi Development Authority for the lease of the property
- 103 described in subsection (1), which shall be composed of the
- 104 following members:
- 105 The respective chairmen of the Public Property
- 106 Committees and Education Committees of the House of
- 107 Representatives and the Senate;
- 108 (b) One (1) member of the House of Representatives who
- 109 resides in Hinds County, to be appointed by the Speaker of the
- House; and 110
- 111 One (1) member of the Senate who resides in Hinds
- 112 County, to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor.

113 Before selecting the private developer to which to lease the
114 property described in subsection (1), and while negotiating the
115 terms of the lease with the private developer that has been
116 selected, the Mississippi Development Authority shall consult with
117 the advisory committee and consider any suggestions and
118 recommendations made by the advisory committee regarding the lease
119 of the property.

120 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 121 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, 2 TO LEASE FOR A CERTAIN NUMBER OF YEARS THE PROPERTY FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE "OLD SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND" WHICH IS LOCATED NORTH OF EASTOVER DRIVE IN THE CITY OF JACKSON, HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; TO REQUIRE THE PROPERTY TO BE LEASED FOR PRIVATE REDEVELOPMENT 5 6 RESULTING IN ITS HIGHEST AND BEST USE; TO REQUIRE THAT THE LEASE 7 8 BE APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE; TO REQUIRE THE LEASE TO 9 CONTAIN A PROVISION REQUIRING THAT THE LESSEE CONSTRUCT A NEW 10 RESIDENCE FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND AND A NEW STORAGE AND BUILDING MAINTENANCE FACILITY ON THE 11 12 GROUNDS OF THE NEW CAMPUS FOR THE SCHOOL; TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND 13 INTO WHICH THE PROCEEDS OF THE LEASE MONIES SHALL BE DEPOSITED, TO 14 BE USED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND 15 AND THE MISSISSIPPI SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
