## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3125

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. That the following sum, or so much thereof as may
7	be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State
8	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees
9	of State Institutions of Higher Learning to be used for the
10	operation of the College of Veterinary Medicine at Mississippi
11	State University, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and
12	ending June 30, 2008\$ 15,872,898.00.
13	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
15	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the College of
17	Veterinary Medicine at Mississippi State University, for the
18	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
19	\$ 9,389,411.00.
20	SECTION 3. Any transfer shall be made in accordance with the
21	terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
22	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
23	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
24	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
25	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
26	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
27	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to
28	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
29	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
30	during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Six 31 32 Hundred Three Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$603,725.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund 33 34 from funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, 35 Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 36 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 37 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 38 39 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 40 intended mission of this agency. A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for Fiscal Year 2009.

70 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 71 72 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 73 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 74 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 75 76 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 77

78 SECTION 8. It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial 79 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further, 80 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for 81 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner. 82 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe

83 the following criteria:

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(1) Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.

85 (2) Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising86 standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness.

87 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired88 by media without cost.

89 (4) Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
90 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
91 media expenditures.

Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible. 92 (5) 93 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 94 95 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 96 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 97 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 98 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from 99

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and after July 1, 2007.
