## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3140

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

11	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

20	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of									
21	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be

The following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 38 General Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Fair 39 40 Commission as follows: For the support of annual roundup shows for junior 41 42 exhibitors of junior steers, junior breeding cattle, beef cattle, dairy cattle, hogs, sheep and poultry, for the fiscal year 43 44 beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008...... 45 \$ 46 (b) To supplement the funds paid by the Mississippi 47 Fair Commission for livestock premiums at the State Fair, all livestock premiums to be paid on the American system of judging 48 (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, etc.) on all classes entered in the senior 49 division for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 50 June 30, 2008.....\$ 51 For the county livestock shows in offering and 52 paying prizes or awards to competitors in the approved county 53 livestock shows of Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning 54 July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... \$ 55 13,138.00. Provided, however, that of the amount herein appropriated in 56 57 subsection (c), not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be expended or used in any one county of the state during 58 59 each fiscal year. Provided, further, that none of the monies herein appropriated in subsection (c) shall be used in offering or 60 paying prizes or awards for any livestock show that is not held 61 where there are adequate barns, pens and other facilities 62 63 available for such a show. 64 Provided, further, in subsection (c) that the management of such shows shall be in the hands of a county livestock 65 66 association, and such association shall guarantee a minimum amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be used in the paying of 67 prizes, premiums or awards, and after said county show has been 68 held and premiums paid, fifty percent (50%) of the amount, not 69 exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), shall be paid upon 70

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          Provided, further, in subsection (c) that in any county which
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     has two (2) shows with proper facilities, and a contiguous county
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     has no such fair and desires to participate in a fair to be held
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     in an adjoining county, each of the two (2) fairs in one (1)
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     county may receive an equal proportion of the funds hereby
     appropriated, provided, both shows shall not receive an aggregate
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     sum of more than One Thousand Dollars ($1,000.00).

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          Provided, further, that no part of the money herein
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     appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall
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     be used for any other purpose than to pay premium awards at said
     shows and state shows and expositions receiving legislative
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     appropriation shall not conflict in dates in order that livestock
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     exhibitors may make the circuit of shows. Provided, further, that
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     none of the above mentioned funds shall be paid to any district
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     shows unless shows are held prior to roundup.
         Not less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the funds herein
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     appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall
     be used in awarding prizes or premiums to 4-H Club members and
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     Smith-Hughes School members and other boys and girls having
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     entries in said shows.
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          All funds herein appropriated under the provisions of
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All funds herein appropriated under the provisions of
subsections (d) and (e) for the five (5) district livestock shows
and the five (5) fall state dairy shows shall be distributed in
such manner that the livestock exhibitors will each draw equal
premium awards for comparable grades and placings at each of the
said five (5) district spring shows and the five (5) fall state

107 shows. The management of each district spring show and each state

108 fall show shall submit to the Mississippi Fair Commission, within

109 fifteen (15) days after the close of each said show, a full report

110 on the number of exhibitors at each said show, with the grades and

- 111 placings of the different classes of livestock exhibited.
- 112 The Executive Secretary of the Mississippi Fair Commission,
- 113 together with a committee of three (3) to be named by the
- 114 President of the Mississippi Livestock Council from that
- 115 organization, shall summarize and prepare a unified list of awards
- 116 for like classes in all spring district livestock shows and fall
- 117 state dairy shows receiving state premium money, as authorized in
- 118 subsections (d) and (e). The Executive Secretary and Chairman of
- 119 the Mississippi Fair Commission shall approve and present a
- 120 requisition to the State Fiscal Officer for the payment of the

- 131 exhibitors will each draw equal premium awards for comparable
- 132 grades and placings at each district spring show, and the fall

- 152 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 153 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 154 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 155 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 156 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 157 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 158 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 159 made without competitive bids.
- 160 **SECTION 6.** It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial
- 161 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further,
- 162 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for
- 163 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner.
- 164 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe
- 165 the following criteria:
- 166 (1) Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.
- 167 (2) Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising
- 168 standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness.
- 169 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired
- 170 by media without cost.
- 171 (4) Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
- 172 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
- 173 media expenditures.
- 174 (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible.

175 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 176 177 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 178 179 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 180 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 181 and after July 1, 2007. 182
