170 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 171 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 172 173 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 174 175 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 176 act. 177 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 178 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 179 180 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 181 182 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 183 184 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 185 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 186 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 187 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

188 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 189 190 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 191 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 192 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 193 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 194 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 195 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 196 appropriated level.

197 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 198 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 199 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 200 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless

specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 205 206 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 207 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 208 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 209 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 210 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 211 212 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 213 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 214 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 215 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise authorized in this act. 216

SECTION 4. The Commissioner of Public Safety may, on a 217 case-by-case basis, within funds available, recommend that 218 219 corrective salary adjustments be made to the compensation of employees of the Department of Public Safety where an inequity was 220 221 created between employees of equivalent capacity by previous 222 application of the agency appropriation acts. Any such corrective 223 salary adjustment plan must have prior approval by the State 224 Such adjustments will not be retroactive. Personnel Board.

Any funds in the Salary, Wages and Fringe Benefits major object of expenditure may be used to purchase accumulated compensatory time within funds available.

SECTION 5. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall have the authority to transfer both positions and/or State General Funds appropriated herein from any Division within the Department of Public Safety to any other Division within the Department of Public Safety, not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%).

233 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 234 local governments pay for part of the computer cost of the 235 Mississippi Justice Information Center by maintaining their 236 contribution to the Department of Public Safety.

237 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 238 Department of Public Safety designate certain employees to aid the 239 Division of Crime Laboratories in the billing and collecting of

240 all fees charged for services rendered by the Division of Crime 241 Laboratories.

SECTION 8. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be 242 243 transferred to, expended by, or used, directly or indirectly, for 244 the benefit of any public relations, publicity or publication 245 activities of any other state agency, department or officer, nor shall any personnel paid with funds appropriated herein be 246 247 transferred or assigned to any other state agency, department or 248 officer for public relations, publicity, or publication activities 249 of such office.

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Department of Public Safety shall have the authority to receive, budget and expend funds from any source in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

256 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 257 Department of Public Safety shall not issue citations for 258 violations of speed limits on a quota basis. No funds expended 259 under this act shall be used for such quota-based citations for 260 violations of speed limits.

261 SECTION 11. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall have the 262 authority to transfer Department of Public Safety Special Funds 263 from any Division within the Department of Public Safety to any 264 other Division of the Department of Public Safety Special Funds, 265 including, but not limited to, Funds 3711, 371C, 371E, 3713, 3714, 3715, 3740, 3741, 3742, 3744, 3747 and 3718, not to exceed Six 266 267 Million Dollars (\$6,000,000.00) collectively during Fiscal Year 268 Further, the Department of Public Safety shall be 2008. 269 authorized to escalate both funds and positions for any special 270 fund monies received for Homeland Security.

SECTION 12. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the

intended mission of this agency. A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for Fiscal Year 2009.

350 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that all divisions within the Mississippi Department of Public Safety shall 351 maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the 352 353 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 354 355 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of 356 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 357 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 358 359 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request 360 process.

361 SECTION 14. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 362 of Section 2, funds may be expended to defray the costs of 363 clothing for sworn nonuniform law enforcement officers in an 364 amount not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually per 365 officer.

366 SECTION 15. It is the intention of the Legislature that all 367 Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) nonexempt sworn officers who are 368 working 171 hours in a 28-day work cycle be compensated at an 369 hourly rate based on 2,087.143 hours per year. This section and 370 its provisions shall be known and cited as the "David R. Huggins 371 Act of 2002".

372 SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that 373 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 374 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 375 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 376 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 377 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 378 379 made without competitive bids.

380 **SECTION 17.** Of the funds provided herein, the sworn officers 381 of the Department of Public Safety shall receive a Three Thousand 382 Dollar (\$3,000.00) pay raise.

383 SECTION 18. The department is authorized to expend available 384 funds on technology or equipment upgrades or replacements when it 385 will generate savings through efficiency or when the savings 386 generated from such upgrades or replacements exceed expenditures 387 thereof.

388 **SECTION 19.** It is legislative intent to ensure beneficial 389 information reaches as many Mississippians as possible. Further, 390 it is legislative intent that the expenditure of public funds for 391 this purpose be accomplished in an efficient and effective manner. 392 Therefore, state agencies as standard procedure, will observe 393 the following criteria:

394

(1) Develop goals and desired result for a campaign.

395 (2) Evaluate effectiveness through respected advertising396 standards, including market reach and cost effectiveness.

397 (3) Seek public service announcements, which would be aired398 by media without cost.

399 (4) Itemize and justify professional assistance and related
400 expenses for creative and production costs outside of the actual
401 media expenditures.

402 (5) Utilize Mississippi owned media companies when feasible.
403 SECTION 20. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
404 of Section 2, Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) shall be
405 derived from the Working Cash-Stabilization Reserve Fund.

406 SECTION 21. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 407 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 408 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 409 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 410 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 411 SECTION 22. This act shall take effect and be in force from 412 413 and after July 1, 2007.
