House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3158

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever is greater.

39 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 40 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 42 43 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 44 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 45 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 47 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 49 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 50 51 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 52 53 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 54 55 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 56 57 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 58 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 59 60 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

74 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 75 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 76 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 77 78 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 79 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 80 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 81 82 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 83 84 of a departing employee with an individual from within state service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 85 86 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 87 88 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 89 authorized in this act.

90 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 91 of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act shall 92 be expended to defray any expenses of the Motor Vehicle Commission 93 if said commission takes any official actions during Fiscal Year 94 2008 that serve directly or indirectly to reduce the payment to 95 the State General Fund of any sales tax on motor vehicles sold 96 within the State of Mississippi.

97 It is further the intention of the Legislature that if such 98 actions are taken by the Motor Vehicle Commission during Fiscal 99 Year 2008, the executive director and commission members shall be 100 held personally liable for repayment of any funds expended under 101 the provisions of this act with said repayment to be made to the 102 State General Fund. The Attorney General is hereby authorized and 103 directed to undertake appropriate legal action to enforce the 104 provisions of this act and to recover said funds.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 105 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 106 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 107 108 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 109 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 110 111 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 112

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 113 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 114 115 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 116 117 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 118 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 119 120 and after July 1, 2007.
