COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

Senate Bill No. 2102

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 99-3-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
6 amended as follows:
7 99-3-39. (1) Boards of supervisors of the various counties
8 of this state and the governing authorities of the municipalities,
9 may either separately or in conjunction with each other, within
10 their discretion, offer monetary rewards, the amount of which
11 shall be fixed by the aforesaid governing authorities, within
12 their discretion, for information leading to the apprehension of
13 any person subsequently convicted of any crime or misdemeanor
14 committed within this state; information regarding the whereabouts
15 of missing persons; the ascertaining or divulging of any
16 information necessary or helpful for the governing or the
17 tranquility of any municipality or county of this state or for any
18 like purpose, provided said reward shall not exceed the sum of
19 Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) and provided further, that
20 said reward shall not be paid to any law enforcement officer or
21 any employee of the governing authority offering such reward or
22 any member of the immediate family of either.

23 (2) The aforesaid rewards may be paid from the general fund
24 of the respective counties or municipalities.

25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
26 and after July 1, 2007.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**
