Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Board of Registered
8	Professional Geologists for the purpose of defraying the expenses
9	of the Board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and
10	ending June 30, 2008\$ 122,559.00.
11	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
12	of this act, the following positions are authorized and shall be
13	under the authority of the State Personnel Board:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time 1
16	Part Time 0
17	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
18	Part Time 0
19	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
20	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
21	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
22	Plan or One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00), whichever
23	is greater.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 24 25 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 26 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 27 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 28 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 29 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 31 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 32 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 34 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 35 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 36 37 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 38 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 39 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 40 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 41 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 43 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 46 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 48 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 49 50 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 51 52 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 53 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 54 appropriated level.

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 55 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 59 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 60 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 61 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 62 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 63 64 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 65 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 66 67 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 68 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
- service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
 authorized in this act.

 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that

of a departing employee with an individual from within state

- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

 84 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

 86 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

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- 87 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 88 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 89 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 90 and after July 1, 2007.
