Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill No. 3203

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 11 SECTION 1. As used in this act, the following terms shall
- 12 have the following meanings unless a different meaning is clearly
- 13 indicated by the context in which they are used:
- 14 (a) "Governing authorities" means the governing
- 15 authorities of the City of Bay Springs, Mississippi.
- 16 (b) "Restaurant" means all places where prepared food
- 17 and beverages are sold for consumption, whether such food is
- 18 consumed on the premises or not. "Restaurant" as defined herein
- 19 does not include any school, hospital, convalescent or nursing
- 20 home, or any restaurant-like facility operated by or in connection
- 21 with a school, hospital, medical clinic, convalescent or nursing
- 22 home providing food for students, patients, visitors and their
- 23 families.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** (1) For the purpose of providing funds to reduce
- 25 the indebtedness incurred and to be incurred by the City of Bay
- 26 Springs in funding the purchase of land and the construction of a
- 27 sports complex consisting of baseball fields, soccer fields,
- 28 walking trails and other athletic facilities, the governing
- 29 authorities are authorized, in their discretion, to levy and

- 30 collect from the persons hereinafter specified a tax, which shall
- 31 be in addition to all of the taxes and assessments imposed. The
- 32 tax shall be imposed upon every person, firm or corporation
- 33 operating a restaurant or such other business, where prepared food
- 34 or beverages are sold to the public in the City of Bay Springs,
- 35 Mississippi, at a rate not to exceed two percent (2%) of the gross
- 36 proceeds of the sales of beverages sold for on-premises
- 37 consumption and prepared food.
- 38 (2) Persons, firms or corporations liable for the levy
- 39 imposed under subsection (1) of this section shall add the amount
- 40 of the levy to the sales price of the products set out herein and
- 41 shall collect, insofar as is practicable, the amount of the tax
- 42 due by them from the person receiving the services or product at
- 43 the time of payment therefor.
- 44 (3) Such tax shall be collected by and paid to the
- 45 Mississippi State Tax Commission on a form prescribed by the State
- 46 Tax Commission in the manner that state sales taxes are computed,
- 47 collected and paid; and full enforcement provisions and all other
- 48 provisions of Chapter 65, Title 27, Mississippi Code of 1972,
- 49 shall apply as necessary to the implementation and administration
- 50 of this act.
- 51 (4) The proceeds of such tax, less three percent (3%)
- 52 thereof which shall be retained by the State Tax Commission to
- 53 defray the cost of collection, shall be paid to the governing
- 54 authorities of the City of Bay Springs, Mississippi, on or before
- 55 the fifteenth day of the month following the month in which
- 56 collected.
- 57 (5) The proceeds of such tax shall not be considered by the
- 58 City of Bay Springs as general fund revenues but shall be
- 59 dedicated to and expended solely for the purposes specified in
- 60 this section.

61 SECTION 3. Before any tax authorized under this act may be 62 imposed, the governing authorities shall adopt a resolution 63 declaring their intention to levy the tax, setting forth the 64 amount of the tax to be imposed, the date upon which the tax shall 65 become effective and calling for an election to be held on the 66 question. The date of the election shall be fixed in the resolution. Notice of such intention and the election shall be 67 published once each week for at least three (3) consecutive weeks 68 in a newspaper published or having a general circulation in the 69 70 City of Bay Springs, with the first publication of the notice to 71 be made not less than twenty-one (21) days before the date fixed in the resolution for the election and the last publication to be 72 73 made not more than seven (7) days before the election. At the 74 election, all qualified electors of the City of Bay Springs may 75 vote, and the ballots used in the election shall have printed 76 thereon a brief statement of the amount and purposes of the 77 proposed tax levy and the words "FOR THE TAX" and, on a separate line, "AGAINST THE TAX" and the voters shall vote by placing a 78 79 cross (X) or check $(\sqrt{})$ opposite their choice on the proposition. 80 When the results of the election shall have been canvassed and 81 certified, the city may levy the tax if sixty percent (60%) of the 82 qualified electors who vote in the election vote in favor of the 83 At least thirty (30) days before the effective date of the tax provided in this section, the governing authorities shall 84 85 furnish to the State Tax Commission a certified copy of the resolution evidencing the tax. 86 87 SECTION 4. Accounting for receipts and expenditures of the funds herein described shall be made separately from the 88 accounting of receipts and expenditures of the general fund and 89 90 any other funds of the City of Bay Springs, Mississippi. records reflecting the receipts and expenditures of the funds 91 92 prescribed herein shall be audited annually by an independent

- 93 certified public accountant, and the accountant shall make a
- 94 written report of his audit to the governing authorities. The
- 95 audit shall be made and completed as soon as practicable after the
- 96 close of the fiscal year, and expenses of such audit shall be paid
- 97 from the funds derived in accordance with this act.
- 98 **SECTION 5.** The provisions of this act shall be repealed from
- 99 and after July 1, 2027.
- 100 **SECTION 6.** The governing authorities of the City of Bay
- 101 Springs are directed to submit this act, immediately upon approval
- 102 by the Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to
- 103 a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the
- 104 United States District Court for the District of Columbia in
- 105 accordance with the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965,
- 106 as amended and extended.
- 107 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 108 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 109 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF BAY SPRINGS, MISSISSIPPI, TO LEVY A TAX UPON THE GROSS SALES OF

3 RESTAURANTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED 2% OF GROSS SALES OF

- 4 BEVERAGES SOLD FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION AND PREPARED FOOD FOR
- 5 THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS TO REDUCE THE INDEBTEDNESS INCURRED
- 6 AND TO BE INCURRED BY THE CITY IN FUNDING THE PURCHASE OF LAND AND
- 7 THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SPORTS COMPLEX CONSISTING OF BASEBALL
- 8 FIELDS, SOCCER FIELDS, WALKING TRAILS AND OTHER ATHLETIC
- 9 FACILITIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
