Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1033

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. Acting on behalf of the State of Mississippi, the 15 Department of Finance and Administration shall convey to the 16 17 University of Mississippi Medical Center certain state-owned real property, and any improvements, rights and appurtenances thereon, 18 that is known as the old Farmers' Market and located in Jackson, 19 Mississippi, subject to the conditions set forth in this section, 20 21 which shall be specified with particularity in the conveyance 22 document: The property shall be used by the University of 23 (a) 24 Mississippi Medical Center exclusively as a research park, and if the property is not so used within five (5) years from the 25 effective date of this act, then the title to the property and all 26 improvements, rights and appurtenances thereon shall revert to and 27 28 be vested in the State of Mississippi. 29 A portion of the property, as approved by the Department of Finance and Administration, shall be reserved 30 31 exclusively for the construction of the Mississippi Industries for the Blind facility and of the State Records Center, both of which 32 33 have been authorized under Sections 97 through 118, Chapter 1, Laws of 2004 Third Extraordinary Session, as amended by Section 34 35 13, Chapter 538, Laws of 2006 Regular Session, and such portion of the property may not be used for any other purpose. 36 However, if either the State Records Office or the Mississippi Industries for 37 the Blind finds a more suitable facility or location in the City 38

of Jackson based on construction costs, financing costs and time

for occupancy that, acting through the Department of Finance and

- 41 Administration, such entity either purchase or lease purchase,
- then the land reserved for that entity under this act and 42
- authorized under Sections 97 through 118, Chapter 1, Laws of 2004 43
- Third Extraordinary Session, as amended by Section 13, Chapter 44
- 538, Laws of 2006 Regular Session, shall be transferred to the 45
- University of Mississippi Medical Center under the terms included 46
- 47 herein.
- 48 (C) After the conveyance of the property, the
- Department of Finance and Administration shall have jurisdiction 49
- 50 over the enforcement of all laws of the State of Mississippi on
- the property and shall provide the security personnel and 51
- equipment necessary to maintain safety and order on the property. 52
- (d) The State of Mississippi shall retain all mineral 53
- 54 rights in the property.
- **SECTION 2.** If the property generally known as the 55
- 56 "Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Property," and more
- 57 particularly described in Section 55-23-8, Mississippi Code of
- 1972, is offered for sale, lease or other conveyance or transfer, 58
- 59 by the State of Mississippi, at any time after the effective date
- 60 of this act, then the University of Mississippi Medical Center
- 61 shall have preference in any opportunities that may exist to
- 62 obtain the property.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 63
- and after July 1, 2007, and shall stand repealed from and after 64
- 65 June 30, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION SHALL CONVEY TO THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI 1 MEDICAL CENTER CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE OLD FARMERS' 3 MARKET AND LOCATED IN JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI; TO REQUIRE THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER SHALL USE THE PROPERTY FOR A RESEARCH PARK; TO REQUIRE THAT A PORTION OF THE PROPERTY SHALL BE RESERVED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI INDUSTRIES FOR THE BLIND FACILITY AND THE STATE 8 9 RECORDS CENTER; TO PROVIDE THAT IF THE PROPERTY GENERALLY KNOWN AS 10 THE "MISSISSIPPI VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM PROPERTY," IS OFFERED 11 BY THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI FOR SALE, LEASE OR OTHER CONVEYANCE OR TRANSFER, THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER SHALL HAVE 12

PREFERENCE IN OBTAINING THE PROPERTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
