## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1114

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. In addition to any other monetary penalties and 5 other penalties imposed by law, any municipality having a 6 7 population of fifteen thousand (15,000) or more according to the most recent federal decennial census may assess an additional 8 surcharge in an amount not to exceed One Dollar (\$1.00) for each 9 violation of Title 63 and offenses related to vehicular parking or 10 registration. The proceeds from the surcharge shall be dedicated 11 12 to the use of the municipal police department and used solely to offset the cost of implementation of certain computerized crime 13 prevention measures and the equipment necessary therefor. 14

15 SECTION 2. This act shall be codified in Chapter 9, Title 16 63, Mississippi Code of 1972, relating to traffic violations 17 procedure.

18 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 19 and after July 1, 2007.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE IMPOSITION OF A ONE DOLLAR SURCHARGE 2 ON ALL TRAFFIC TICKETS ISSUED IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES TO FUND 3 COMPUTERIZED CRIME PREVENTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
