## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1275

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 Section 55-23-8, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 55-23-8. (1) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 8 9 Commission, in its discretion, is authorized to enter into one or 10 more lease agreements with one or more public or private entities in regard to the granting of a property interest to such public or 11 12 private entities in all or any part of the real property located 13 in Hinds County, Mississippi, generally known as the "Mississippi 14 Veterans Memorial Stadium Property, " being any property under the 15 jurisdiction of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium 16 Commission and any other state-owned property located in the area 17 bounded on the North by Taylor Street, on the West by North West Street, on the South by Woodrow Wilson Avenue and on the East by 18 19 North State Street used as part of or in connection with Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium, for the purpose of the 20 construction of improvements thereon. 2.1 22 (2) Any lease authorized in this section may be for such 23 consideration as determined appropriate by the Mississippi 24 Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission and may be for a primary term not to exceed twenty-five (25) years and may be renewed for a term 25

In and for the consideration to be provided under any 34 35 lease, the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, in 36 its discretion, is authorized to, on such terms and conditions 37 determined to be appropriate by the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission: (a) enter into agreements with any such 38 39 lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not exceeding 40 41 the term of such lease (including renewals and extensions) permitting use of any property referred to in subsection (1) of 42 43 this section for parking, access and other uses in connection with 44 events in facilities constructed on property leased from the 45 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission; (b) grant, as part of and for the term of any lease, to any lessee or lessees 46 47 (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees), one or more 48 easements with respect to all or any part of the property referred 49 to in subsection (1) of this section for vehicle and pedestrian 50 ingress and egress, for vehicle parking and for such other purposes necessary and appropriate for the construction, operation 51 52 and use of the improvements; (c) enter into agreements with any 53 such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or 54 lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not exceeding the term of such lease (including renewals and 55 extensions), permitting use by such lessee or lessees (or any 56 57 designee of any such lessee or lessees) of Mississippi Veterans 58 Memorial Stadium for events; (d) enter into agreements with any 59 such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees), which agreements may extend over any period of time not 60 61 exceeding the term of such lease (including renewals and 62 extensions), pursuant to which the state shall be obligated to 63 purchase improvements constructed on such property and/or any residual rights in connection with such improvements upon terms 64

and for a purchase price, not to exceed Ten Million Dollars

(\$10,000,000.00), as set forth in or determined in accordance with

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     such agreement; (e) enter into agreements with any such lessee or
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     lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees) providing
     that such lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or
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     lessees) shall indemnify and hold harmless the Mississippi
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     Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission for any personal injury or
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     property damage related to events conducted on property leased
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     from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission; and/or
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     (f) enter into such other agreements with any such lessee or
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     lessees (or any designee of any such lessee or lessees) or any
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     other public or private entities, which agreements may extend over
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     any period of time not exceeding the term of such lease (including
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     renewals and extensions), relating to any such lease and any
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     improvements to be constructed on property leased from the
     Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission as the
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     Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission shall determine
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     to be appropriate. However, the State of Mississippi shall not be
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     obligated to purchase any improvements constructed on property
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     leased under this section and/or any residual rights in connection
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     with such improvements unless the construction of all such
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     improvements on the property is complete. The Department of
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     Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building,
     Grounds and Real Property Management, shall make the determination
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     regarding whether the construction of the improvements is
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     complete.
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               Any public body shall be authorized to enter into:
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     agreements (which may extend over any period of time) with the
     Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, any public body,
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     any party leasing property from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial
     Stadium Commission (or any designee or designees of any such
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     lessee), and/or any other party to provide or contribute funds in
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     connection with the construction, financing and/or operation of
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     any improvements constructed on property leased from the
     Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, and any such
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     agreement or agreements and the obligations of any public body
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thereunder shall not be included in computing amounts subject to

103 (b) agreements (which may extend over any period of time) to lease

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- 112 (5) The Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission, in 113 its discretion, is authorized to enter into all other agreements 114 as may be necessary or appropriate in connection with any 115 financing by any lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such 116 lessee or lessees) of any improvements to be constructed on 117 property leased from the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium
- 119 (6) The provisions of any statutes establishing a role for 120 the Department of Finance and Administration and the State Bond 121 Commission in financing, construction and improvement of buildings 122 on the Veterans Memorial Stadium property shall not apply to the 123 financing, refinancing, construction, repair or improvement of any

improvements on any property leased pursuant to this section.

(7) Before entering into any lease or other agreement with any private entity under this section, the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission shall require such entity to enter into a binding commitment providing that if the private entity fails to complete the construction of all improvements commenced by the entity on property leased under this section, such entity shall reimburse the State of Mississippi for costs incurred by the state relating to the improvements. The Department of Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management shall make the determination regarding whether the construction of the improvements is complete.

- 136 (8) Any lease or other agreement entered into by the
- 137 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission under this
- 138 section shall not be valid unless approved by the Department of
- 139 Finance and Administration, the Public Procurement Review Board
- 140 and the Attorney General.
- 141 (9) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2), the
- 142 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission may not enter
- 143 into any lease or other agreement under this section after October
- 144 1, 2001.
- 145 (10) Any lessee or lessees (or any designee of any such
- 146 lessee or lessees) of property leased from the Mississippi
- 147 Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission under this section shall not
- 148 be considered as being the state, any political subdivision of the
- 149 state or any officer or servant of the state for the purposes of
- 150 any liability that may be waived under Section 11-46-1 et seq.,
- 151 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 152 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after July 1, 2007, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 154 June 30, 2007.

## Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 55-23-8, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 ALLOW EXISTING LEASES ON ALL OR ANY PART OF THE MISSISSIPPI
- 3 VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM PROPERTY TO BE CONVERTED, AT THE OPTION
- 4 OF THE LESSEE, TO 40-year Leases; and for related purposes.
