Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1653

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Physical
9	Therapy, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
10	Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy for the fiscal year
11	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
12	\$ 249,667.00.
13	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
14	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
15	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
16	Permanent: Full Time 3
17	Part Time0
18	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
19	Part Time0
20	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
21	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
22	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
23	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
24	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
25	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
26	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
27	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
28	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
29	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
30	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
31	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the

- 32 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 33 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 34
- 35 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act.
- 36 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 37
- Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 38
- 39 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 40
- has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 41
- projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 42
- 43 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 44 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 45 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 46 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 47
- 48 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 49 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 50
- approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 51
- 52 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 53
- 54 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 55 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 56
- 57 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 58 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 59 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 60
- 61 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- 62 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
- means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 63
- specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 64
- 65 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
- 66 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an

67 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public

68 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as

- 69 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
- 70 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
- 71 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
- 72 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
- 73 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
- 74 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
- 75 authorized in this act.
- 76 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 77 Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain
- 78 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 79 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 80 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 81 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of
- 82 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 83 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 84 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 85 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request
- 86 process.
- 87 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 90 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 91 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 93 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 94 made without competitive bids.
- 95 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 96 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 97 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 98 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 99 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 100 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2007.
