## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1654

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## **AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9	Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of
10	the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of
11	defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of
12	the Public Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building
14	Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose
15	of maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System
16	Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
17	June 30, 2008\$ 11,079,902.00.
18	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
20	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

40	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
41	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
42	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
43	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
44	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
45	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
46	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
47	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
48	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
49	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
50	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
51	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
52	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
53	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
54	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
55	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
56	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
57	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
58	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
59	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
60	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
61	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
62	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
63	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
64	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
65	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
66	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

67 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 68 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 69 70 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 71 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 72 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 73 74 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 75 appropriated level. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 76 77 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 78 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 79 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 80 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 81 82 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 83 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 84 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 85 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 86 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 87 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 88 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 89 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 90 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 91 92 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 93 94 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise authorized in this act. 95 96 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

96 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
97 Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System shall
98 maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the
99 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
100 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
101 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of

- 102 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 103 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 104
- 105 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request
- 106 process.
- SECTION 4. In accordance with the purposes of this article, 107
- there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public 108
- 109 Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund,
- 110 into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income
- from the building owned by the system located at 301 North 111
- President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal 112
- 113 year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the
- 114 Administrative Budget Fund of the system.
- It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have 115
- 116 the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System
- Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed 117
- 118 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for repair and
- 119 maintenance of the buildings owned by the system.
- expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building 120
- 121 Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this
- 122 article and for the purposes designated herein.
- 123 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 124 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 125 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 126 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 127 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 128
- 129 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 130 made without competitive bids.
- 131 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 132 Executive Director of the Public Employees' Retirement System may
- increase major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 133
- exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of 134
- 135 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major
- 136 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar

137	amount and provided the Executive Director of the Mississippi
138	Department of Finance and Administration also approves with
139	written authorization. However, no transfers shall be authorized
140	which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages
141	and Fringe Benefits."
142	SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein
143	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
144	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
145	to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of the Public
146	Employees' Retirement System, for the purpose of defraying those
147	expenses associated with consultant services regarding a
148	replacement computer system, for the fiscal year beginning July 1
149	2007, and ending June 30, 2008\$ 480,458.00
150	SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
151	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
152	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
153	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
154	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
155	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law

SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2007.
