## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1661

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## **AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out
7	of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available
8	to the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, for the purpose
9	of defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
11	\$ 15,522,279.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15	expenditure:

34	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
35	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
36	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
37	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
38	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
39	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
40	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
41	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
42	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
43	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
44	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
45	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
46	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
47	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
48	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
49	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
50	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
51	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
52	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
53	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
54	Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
55	has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
56	projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
57	appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
58	reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
59	requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
60	such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
61	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
62	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
63	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
64	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
65	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The

66 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written

67 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 68

69 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 70

71 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

73 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

74 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise

75 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,

76 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other

means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 77

78 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of

79 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the

80 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an

educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 81

82 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as

determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 83

84 of a departing employee with an individual from within state

85 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the

86 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,

pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 87

determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise

authorized in this act. 89

90 With the funds herein appropriated, funds are included and

authorized in the Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits major object 91

of expenditure to pay "call back pay" in lieu of "compensatory 92

93 time credit," at the discretion of the Director of the Pearl River

Valley Water Supply District, to any employee who must work on a 94

95 statutory holiday or any holiday proclaimed by the Governor.

96 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

97 Pearl River Valley Water Supply District shall maintain complete

accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 98

99 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be

100 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 101 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that

102 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be

103 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

104 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail

105 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

106 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that

107 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

108 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

109 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

110 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

111 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

112 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

113 made without competitive bids.

114 **SECTION 5.** The funds herein approved for expenditure, except

115 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which

shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations,

shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the

118 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent

119 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills

120 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.

121 **SECTION 6.** The Pearl River Valley Water Supply District is

authorized to expend any federal or state funds to repair damage

caused by Hurricane Katrina on the shoreline located between the

124 Bob Anthony Parkway and the causeway on either public or private

125 property.

126 **SECTION 7.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall

127 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer

128 or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with

129 the provisions of a valid trust indenture.

130 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

131 and after July 1, 2007.
