Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1664

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out
7	of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available
8	to the Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District, for the
9	purpose of paying bond maturities, accrued interest, maintenance
10	expenses, project development costs, and any other authorized
11	expenses of the water management district, for the fiscal year
12	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008

14	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
15	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
16	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

31 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 32 Full Time..... 18 Permanent: 33 Part Time..... 34 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 35 Part Time..... Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation 36 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase 37 38 equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation 39 Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%) whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007. 40 41 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 42 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 43 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 44 45 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 46 47 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 48 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 49 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 50 51 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 52 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 53 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 54 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 55 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 56 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 57 58 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 59 60 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 61 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 63 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 65 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 66
- 67 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 68
- 69 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 70
- 71 appropriated level.
- 72 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 73 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 74 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 75 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 76 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
- 77 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- 78 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
- 79 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
- 80 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
- 81 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
- 82 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
- educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 83
- Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 84
- determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 85
- 86 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
- service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 87
- 88 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
- pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 89
- 90 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
- 91 authorized in this act.
- It is the intention of the Legislature that the 92 SECTION 3.
- 93 Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District shall maintain
- complete accounting and personnel records related to the 94
- 95 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 96 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of 97
- the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 98
- 99 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 100 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level

- 101 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request 102 process.
- section 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that
 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
 made without competitive bids.
- section 5. All monies in possession of the district in
 excess of necessary operating funds shall be deposited with a bank
 or banks selected by the board of directors of the district.

 These funds shall be deposited in such bank or banks and in such
 manner that interest earned shall be at least equal to interest
- SECTION 6. The money herein approved for expenditure shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
