AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

34	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
35	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
36	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
37	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
38	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
39	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
40	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
41	Mississippi Coast Coliseum Commission shall maintain complete
42	accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
43	funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
44	in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
45	Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
46	the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be
47	submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
48	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
49	provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
50	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that
51	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
52	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
53	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
54	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
55	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
56	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
57	made without competitive bids.
58	SECTION 5. The money herein approved for expenditure shall
59	be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
60	or officers, in the manner provided by law.
61	SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2007.
