Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1674

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%) whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

39 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 40 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 42 43 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 44 45 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 47 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 48 49 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 50 51 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 52 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 53 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 54 55 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 56 57 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 58 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 59 60 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

74 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 75 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 76 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 77 78 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 79 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 80 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 81 82 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 83 84 of a departing employee with an individual from within state service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 85 86 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 87 88 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 89 authorized in this act.

90 SECTION 3. None of the funds herein appropriated by this act 91 to the Public Service Commission shall be expended for any purpose 92 that is not actually required or necessary for performing any of 93 the powers or duties of the Mississippi Public Service Commission 94 that are authorized by the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, state 95 or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or 96 federal law.

97 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 98 Public Service Commission shall maintain complete accounting and 99 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 100 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the H B 1674 101 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 102 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 103 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to 104 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 105 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 106 during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 107 108 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury 109 to the credit of the Public Service Commission, for the purpose of 110 defraying the expenses of the Public Service Commission to 111 administer the Mississippi Telephone Solicitation Act, for the 112 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 113 114 160,000.00.

115 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that 116 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 117 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 118 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 119 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 120 121 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 122 made without competitive bids.

123 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 124 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 125 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 126 127 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 128 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 129 130 and after July 1, 2007.
