

Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1676

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8 Treasury to the credit of the Real Estate Appraisal License Fund,
9 for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Real
10 Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board for the fiscal
11 year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008.....
12 \$ 420,445.00.

13 **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
14 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
15 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
16 expenditure:

35 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
36 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
37 equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
38 Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
39 whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

40 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
41 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
42 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
43 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
44 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
45 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
46 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
47 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
48 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
49 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
50 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
51 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
52 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
53 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
54 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
55 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
56 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
57 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
58 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
59 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
60 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
61 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
63 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
64 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
65 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
66 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The

67 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
68 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
69 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
70 appropriated level.

71 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
72 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
73 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
74 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

75 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
76 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
77 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
78 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
79 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
80 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
81 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
82 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
83 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
84 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
85 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
86 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
87 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
88 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
89 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
90 authorized in this act.

91 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of
92 this act, Three Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-seven Dollars
93 (\$3,987.00) is provided to reclassify one position.

94 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
95 Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification
96 Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records
97 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this
98 act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of
99 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the
100 intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for
101 Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative

102 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
103 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008
104 budget request process.

105 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
106 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
107 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
108 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
109 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
110 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
111 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
112 made without competitive bids.

113 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
114 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
115 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
116 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
117 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
118 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

119 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
120 and after July 1, 2007.
