Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1676

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%) whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

40 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 41 42 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 43 44 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the 45 46 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 47 48 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 49 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 50 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 51 52 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 53 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 54 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 55 56 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 57 58 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 59 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 60 61 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 67 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 68 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 69 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 70 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

75 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 76 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 77 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 78 79 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 80 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 81 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 82 83 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 84 85 of a departing employee with an individual from within state service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 86 87 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 88 89 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 90 authorized in this act.

91 SECTION 3. Of the funds provided under the provisions of 92 this act, Three Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-seven Dollars 93 (\$3,987.00) is provided to reclassify one position.

94 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Real Estate Appraiser Licensing and Certification 95 96 Board shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records 97 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of 98 detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the 99 100 intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for 101 Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative

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105 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 106 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 107 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 108 109 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 110 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 111 made without competitive bids. 112

113 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 114 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 115 116 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 117 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 118 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 119 and after July 1, 2007. 120
