Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1679

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

The Legislature shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from the Legislative 87 88 Extraordinary Session Expense Revolving Fund, as authorized in Section 5-1-57, Mississippi Code of 1972, in accordance with rules 89 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 90 a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 91 The 92 authority granted in this section is provided for the purpose of paying the expenses of the members of the Legislature incurred 93 during any Extraordinary Session of the Legislature occurring 94 95 during the period beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 96 June 30, 2008.

97 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this Legislature for 98 99 the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 100 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 101 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 102 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 103 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 104 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 107 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 108 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 109 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 110 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 111 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 112 and after July 1, 2007.
