Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1686

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
7	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Office
8	of Indigent Appeals which is comprised of special source funds
9	collected by or otherwise available for the purpose of defraying
10	the expenses of the Mississippi Office of Indigent Appeals for the
11	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
12	\$ 1,234,245.00.
13	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
14	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
15	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
16	expenditure:

39	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
40	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
41	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
42	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
43	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
44	Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
45	approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
46	without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
47	appropriated level.
48	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
49	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
50	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
51	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
52	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
53	Office of Indigent Appeals shall maintain complete accounting and
54	personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
55	appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
56	same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
57	2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
58	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to
59	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
60	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
61	during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.
62	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that
63	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
64	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
65	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

66 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

67 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

68 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

69 made without competitive bids.

70 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

71 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

72 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

75 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

76 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

77 and after July 1, 2007.
