Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1687

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

15	source funds collected by or otherwise available to the Authority,				
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Authority for the				
17	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008

19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of				
20	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%) whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 50 51 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 52 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008 53 54 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 55 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 56 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 57 58 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 59 60 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 61 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal 62 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 63 64 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 65 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency

has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

72 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 73 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 74 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 75 76 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 77 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 78 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 79 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 80 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 85 86 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, 87 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 88 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 89 90 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 91 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 92 93 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 94 95 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 96 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 97 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 98 99 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 100 authorized in this act.

Funds appropriated herein shall first be used for the continuation of a full and complete broadcast schedule of educational and instructional, professional growth, and public service programs, with the production of new films and programs to be secondary thereto.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 106 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall maintain 107 108 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 109 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 110 111 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of 112 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 113 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 114 115 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request 116 process.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, One Million Six Hundred Forty-four Thousand Sixty-seven Dollars (\$1,644,067.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

122 SECTION 6. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be 123 transferred to, expended by, or used, directly or indirectly, for 124 the benefit of any public relations, publicity or publication 125 activities of any other state agency, department or officer, nor 126 shall any personnel paid or equipment purchased with funds appropriated hereby be transferred or assigned to any other state 127 128 agency, department or officer for public relations, publicity or publication activities of such office. 129

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall have the authority to expend funds in the Capital Equipment Replacement Revolving Fund, in accordance with Section 37-63-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of purchasing technical equipment for operating the educational radio and television facilities.

SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 9. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

It is the intention of the Legislature that the

168 Executive Director of the Mississippi Authority for Educational 169 Television may increase major objects of expenditure in total 170 amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 171 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 172 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a 173 corresponding dollar amount and provided the Executive Director of 174 the Mississippi Department of Finance and Administration also 175 approves with written authorization. However, no transfers shall 176 be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 177 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

178 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that 179 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 180 181 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 182 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 183 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 184 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 185 made without competitive bids.

186 SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that an 187 amount equal to One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per square foot 188 shall be paid to the Executive Office of the State Board of 189 Institutions of Higher Learning to defray utility costs.

SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 190 191 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 192 193 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 194 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 195 196 SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from 197 and after July 1, 2007.
