Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1694

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi River 8 Parkway Commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of 9 the commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and 10 ending June 30, 2008......\$ 23,689.00.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 11 SECTION 2. 12 Mississippi River Parkway Commission shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 13 14 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 15 16 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 17 18 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 19 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 20

21 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 22 23 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 24 25 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 26 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 27 made without competitive bids. 28

29 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 30 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 31 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 32 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 33 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 34 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 35 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2007.
