## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1698

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## **AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
9	maintenance of the State Forestry Commission for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
11	\$ 19,489,615.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Forestry
15	Commission which is comprised of special source funds collected by
16	or otherwise available to the commission, for the support and
17	maintenance of the commission for the fiscal year beginning
18	July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
19	\$ 10,239,093.00.
20	Of the funds specified in this section, Two Hundred Fifty
21	Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be deposited in a fund
22	created in the State Treasury called the "Forest Improvement
23	Revolving Fund." Money in this fund shall be used by the State
24	Forestry Commission to assist in the reforestation and growth
25	improvement of the forests, woodlands, and publicly owned lands of
26	the state, including sixteenth section lands, Camp Shelby,
27	Columbia Training School and colleges and universities.
28	Landowners who contract with the commission for such work shall
29	pay to the commission its actual cost for conducting such work.
30	Money received for this work by the commission shall be paid into

- 31 the State Treasury, and the State Treasurer shall deposit such
- 32 money in the "Forest Improvement Revolving Fund."
- 33 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 34 Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

- 40 Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
- 41 Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
- 42 equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
- 43 Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
- 44 whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
- With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
- 46 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
- 47 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
- 48 Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
- 49 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
- 50 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
- 51 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 52 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 53 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 54 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 55 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 56 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 57 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
- 58 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 59 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 60 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 61 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 62 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
- 63 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 64 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

- 65 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 66 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 67
- the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 68
- allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 69
- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 70
- approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 71
- 72 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 73 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 74 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- appropriated level. 75
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 76
- 77 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 78 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 79 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 80 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
- 81 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 82
- 83 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
- specifically exempted by the following conditions: 84
- 85 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
- next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 86
- educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 87
- Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 88
- determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 89
- 90 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
- service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 91
- 92 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
- pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 93
- 94 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
- 95 authorized in this act.
- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 96
- State Forestry Commission and the Mississippi Institute for Forest 97
- 98 Inventory shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records
- 99 related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this

100	act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of
101	detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the
102	intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for
103	Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative
104	Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the
105	format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008
106	budget request process.
107	SECTION 5. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
108	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
109	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
110	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
111	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
112	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
113	performance measures provided below:

136	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
137	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support of the
138	Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory for the fiscal year
139	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
140	\$ 75,000.00.
141	SECTION 7. In addition to all other sums herein
142	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
143	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
144	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Institute for Forest
145	Inventory which is comprised of special source funds and donations
146	collected by or otherwise available to the Institute for the
147	purpose of defraying the expenses of the Institute for the period
148	beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
149	\$ 263,504.00.
150	SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
151	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
152	under the authority of the State Personnel Board:

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the

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next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 204 205 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 206 207 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 208 of a departing employee with an individual from within state 209 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 210 211 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 212 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise authorized in this act. 213 214 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the State Forestry Commission be allowed to escalate its budget in the 215 216 Capital Outlay: Equipment major object of expenditure, with funds generated from the Forest Acreage Tax, and with funds generated 217 218 from the sale of old equipment and lease of tower sites an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00). 219 220 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the State 221 Forestry Commission be allowed to escalate its budget in the Subsidies, Loans and Grants major object of expenditure, with 222 223 funds generated from the Severance Tax to fund the Forest Resource 224 Development Program in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred 225 Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). The receipt of these funds is 226 hereby authorized and approved, provided such receipts and 227 expenditures are reported and otherwise accounted for in 228 accordance with Section 27-103-101 et seq. and Section 27-104-1 et 229 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 230 231 State Forestry Commission be allowed to escalate part-time positions up to one hundred (100) and expend funds not to exceed 232 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) from any source of 233 234 funds that become available to the commission. This escalation shall be in accordance with rules and regulations of the 235 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent 236 237 with the escalation of federal funds. These positions may be used

to protect life and property during extended periods of extreme

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wildfire occurrences of a minimum of fifty (50) fires per day. 239

240 The escalation of positions and the expenditure of these funds

shall be at the discretion of the State Forester, with written 241

242 notification to the State Personnel Board and the State Fiscal

243 Officer.

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SECTION 11. The Forestry Commission has the authority to 244

purchase from the "General Services Administration" Fire Fighter 245

Catalog and any other GSA Catalog as long as the cost of such

247 items are less than the quotes received.

248 SECTION 12. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a

249 fund designated as the Volunteer Fire Department Equipment

250 Conversion Revolving Fund to be used by the State Forestry

251 Commission to assist in the conversion of vehicles acquired by the

252 State Forestry Commission through the Federal Excess Personal

253 Property Program or by Volunteer Fire Departments through other

means to adapt them for use in the suppression of wildland fires. 254

255 This assistance shall be in the form of fabrication of water tanks

256 or other accessories necessary for the operation of fire

257 suppression units, installation of piping and valves, painting or

other similar or associated component work necessary to place fire

259 suppression equipment into service. It is not for general vehicle

260 maintenance or repair.

261 The Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion Revolving

262 Fund shall be funded by monies received from charges for work and

services performed for Volunteer Fire Departments by the State

264 Forestry Commission. Monies collected from such charges shall be

deposited into the Volunteer Fire Department Equipment Conversion 265

266 Revolving Fund. The State Treasurer shall make disbursements

267 therefrom for payment of materials, supplies and labor upon

268 requisition of the Forestry Commission and upon the issuance of

269 warrants therefor by the Department of Finance and Administration.

270 The amount of monies deposited into the Volunteer Fire

Department Equipment Conversion Fund through this work shall not 271

exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00). Funds in excess of 272

273 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be placed in the State

- 274 Forestry Commission's regular appropriated special funds. Monies
- 275 in this revolving fund are to be considered special funds and
- 276 shall be carried forward from one fiscal year to the next.
- 277 **SECTION 13.** There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
- 278 fund designated as the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund to be
- 279 used by the State Forestry Commission to direct forest management
- 280 activities on the Camden State Forest in Madison County,
- 281 Mississippi. The forest management activities will include, but
- 282 not be limited to, maintenance of property, timber sale activities
- 283 and regeneration work.
- The Camden State Forest Revolving Fund shall be funded by
- 285 monies received from timber sales, leases, and any other source.
- 286 Monies collected from these income sources shall be deposited into
- 287 the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund. The State Treasurer shall
- 288 make disbursements therefrom for payments of materials, supplies
- 289 and labor upon requisition of the State Forestry Commission and
- 290 upon the issuance of warrants therefor by the Department of
- 291 Finance and Administration.
- 292 It is the intention of the Legislature that any revolving
- 293 funds in excess of the budgeted amount needed for the necessary
- 294 operation and maintenance of all properties under the direct
- 295 supervision and management of the State Forestry Commission shall
- 296 remain in the Camden State Forest Revolving Fund for use in future
- 297 years.
- 298 **SECTION 14.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 and
- 299 authorized for expenditure in Section 3, it is the intention of
- 300 the Legislature that Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00)
- 301 shall be transferred to the Department of Agriculture and Commerce
- 302 for the Beaver Control or Eradication Program during the Fiscal
- 303 Year 2007.
- 304 **SECTION 15.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 305 Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory is hereby authorized to
- 306 accept, budget and expend funds, not to exceed One Million Dollars
- 307 (\$1,000,000.00), from any source in accordance with rules and

regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

310 SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that 311 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 312 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 313 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 314 315 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 316 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 317 made without competitive bids.

318 **SECTION 17.** Any person who was an employee of the Forestry
319 Commission who was laid off during Fiscal Year 2006 shall be given
320 first priority in any new employment by the commission.

SECTION 18. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

327 **SECTION 19.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 328 and after July 1, 2007.
