## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1700

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Soil and
8	Water Conservation Commission for the purpose of defraying the
9	administrative expenses of the commission and carrying out the
10	provisions of Section 69-27-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972,
11	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending
12	June 30, 2008\$ 774,385.00.
13	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
15	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Soil and
16	Water Conservation Commission which is comprised of special source
17	funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for
18	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the
19	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
20	\$ 3,365,776.00.
21	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
22	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
23	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
24	expenditure:

47	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
48	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
49	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
50	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
51	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
52	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
53	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
54	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
55	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
56	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
57	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the
58	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
59	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
60	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
61	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
62	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
63	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
64	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal

Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.

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66 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 67 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 68 69 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services" 70 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 71 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 72 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 73 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

74 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 75 76 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 77 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 78 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 79 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 80 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 81 82 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

87 The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 88 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification, realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other 89 90 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless 91 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of 92 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 93 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 94 95 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 96 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement of a departing employee with an individual from within state 97 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the 98 99 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 100 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be

H. B. 1700 PAGE 3 101 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 102 authorized in this act.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 103 104 State Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall maintain 105 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 106 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 107 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 108 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of 109 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 110 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 111 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request 112 113 process.

**SECTION 5.** The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission is hereby authorized to retain all funds generated from the sale of equipment. Any funds made available from the sale of equipment shall be deposited into the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and shall be used solely for the purpose of purchasing equipment.

SECTION 6. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend any proceeds derived from the sale of bonds authorized in Section 69-27-331 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. All expenditures shall be in accordance with conditions provided in Section 69-27-331 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

133 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the 134 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed 135 Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) be used for the purpose H. B. 1700 136 of funding a Beaver Control Cost Share program. The Mississippi 137 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall promulgate rules and regulations for the establishment and operation of the program on 138 139 a fund matching basis with the county unit of government. Funds not expended or encumbered in a county may be transferred to 140 another county during the fiscal year. Only those funds 141 specifically appropriated for the Beaver Control Cost Share 142 143 program shall be used in any such program.

144 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 145 146 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 147 148 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 149 150 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 151

152 SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 153 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 154 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 155 156 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 157 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 158 159 and after July 1, 2007.
