Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1701

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
14	Archives and History which is comprised of special source funds
15	collected by or otherwise available to the department, for the
16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal
17	year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
18	\$ 24,690,125.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
21	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 85

teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the 90

next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 91

educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public 92

determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement 94

95 of a departing employee with an individual from within state

96 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the

97 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,

pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be 98

99 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise

100 authorized in this act.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 101 102 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 103 104 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 105 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 106 107 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 108 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 109 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process. 110 SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 111 112 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 113 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 114 115 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 116 117 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 118 SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the 119 Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the 120 121 maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with 122 the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these 123 charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the 124 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of 125 Archives and History. 126 SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that no part of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for 127 128 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 129 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

- 215 Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives
- 216 and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in
- House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the 217
- 218 preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.
- SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 219
- 220 Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept,
- budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand 221
- 222 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to
- 223 the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section
- 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of 224
- paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New Capitol, the 225
- Old Capitol, the Governor's Mansion, and the War Memorial 226
- 227 Building, in accordance with rules and regulations of the
- Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent 228
- 229 with the escalation of federal funds.
- 230 SECTION 11. Of the funds provided under the provisions of
- this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) is 231
- 232 provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating
- 233 Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only
- 234 President of the Confederate States of America.
- 235 SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 236 Executive Director of the Department of Archives and History may
- authorize increases in any major objects of expenditures in total 237
- amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 238
- 239 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided
- 240 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a

corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.

SECTION 15. Of the funds in Section 1, a sum not to exceed

the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2007.
