## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1704

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## **AMENDMENT NO. 1**

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

| 35 | Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation      |

| 40 | With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of         |
| 41 | the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to    |
| 42 | make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal  |
| 43 | Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008      |
| 44 | funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions  |
| 45 | are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the           |
| 46 | Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the             |
| 47 | Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall         |
| 48 | determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all  |
| 49 | appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this   |
| 50 | act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure   |
| 51 | that no single personnel action increases this projected annual    |
| 52 | cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal       |
| 53 | Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.  |
| 54 | If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal    |
| 55 | Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency    |
| 56 | has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this    |
| 57 | projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"  |
| 58 | appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which |
| 59 | reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation          |
| 60 | requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until   |
| 61 | such time as the requirements of this provision are met.           |
| 62 | Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with      |
| 63 | the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or         |
| 64 | allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State     |
| 65 | Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written       |

66 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The

67 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written

- approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 68
- 69 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 70 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 71
- used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 72
- 73 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 74 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise 75
- 76 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- 77 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other
- 78 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
- 79 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
- 80 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
- next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an 81
- 82 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
- Accountant License or higher level professional certification as 83
- 84 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
- of a departing employee with an individual from within state 85
- 86 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
- departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses, 87
- 88 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
- determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise 89
- 90 authorized in this act.
- 91 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 92 Mississippi Department of Insurance shall maintain complete
- 93 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 94
- in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 95
- 96 Year 2007. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2009 shall be 97
- submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 98
- 99 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 100 provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request process.

101 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 102 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, Fifteen Thousand Seventy-nine Dollars (\$15,079.00) is provided for the 103 104 Mississippi Fire Personnel Minimum Standards and Certification 105 Board. SECTION 5. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 106 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 107 108 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Rural Fire Truck 109 Acquisition Fund to the Mississippi Department of Insurance for 110 the Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance Program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008..... 111 112 4,000,000.00. .....\$ SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 113 114 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 115 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Supplemental Rural Fire Truck Fund, created in Section 1, Laws of 2004, Third 116 117 Extraordinary Session, to the Mississippi Department of Insurance for the Supplemental Rural Fire Truck Acquisition Assistance 118 Program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending 119 120 June 30, 2008.....\$ 2,980,000.00 121 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 122 Section 1 and authorized for expenditure in Section 2, funds in 123 the amount of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) are provided and shall be expended to pay the annual dues for the National 124 125 Conference of Insurance Legislators. SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 126 127 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members 128 of the Mississippi House of Representatives and Mississippi Senate are notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 129 130 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public 131 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has 132 made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 133 134 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following

135 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the

136 Mississippi State Legislature."

137 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of

138 this act, Twenty-two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-four Dollars

139 (\$22,754.00) is provided to reallocate 5 (five) positions and Nine

140 Thousand One Hundred Ninety-five Dollars (\$9,195.00) is provided

141 to reclassify 1 (one) position.

142 **SECTION 10.** It is the intention of the Legislature that

143 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

144 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

145 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

146 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

147 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

148 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

149 made without competitive bids.

150 **SECTION 11.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

152 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

153 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

154 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

155 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

156 **SECTION 12.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

157 and after July 1, 2007.
