Senate Amendments to House Concurrent Resolution No. 98

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after line 3 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

WHEREAS, having an affordable, reliable and plentiful energy 4 5 supply is crucial to our economy, as well as our national and international food supply; and 6 7 WHEREAS, current and future risks to United States energy security are mounting, while domestic and global energy demands 8 are escalating; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi has tremendous renewable 11 energy resources; and WHEREAS, the development of renewable energy resources, 12 including wind power, biodiesel, biomass, methane digesters, 13 ethanol and solar, benefits the environment and will have a direct 14 15 economic benefit to agricultural landowners and rural communities; 16 and 17 WHEREAS, agricultural communities and their partners will experience multiple benefits, including establishing additional 18 markets for agricultural commodities, increasing farm income, 19 creating added-value uses for crops, livestock and their 20 byproducts, and creating new job opportunities; and 21 22 WHEREAS, American agriculture is well positioned to play an expanded role in the development and implementation of new energy 23 24 solutions; and 25 WHEREAS, America's farms and ranches can become the factories that produce a new generation of fuels to help meet the nation's 26 27 energy needs; and

28 WHEREAS, "25 by 25" is an agriculturally led goal that 29 envisions America's farms and ranches producing 25% of America's 30 energy demand by the year 2025, while continuing to produce31 abundant, safe and affordable food and fiber; and

32 WHEREAS, agriculture's role as an energy producer will have a 33 positive effect on national security and trade imbalances, and 34 will serve as a catalyst for rural development in the State of 35 Mississippi:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That we, the members of the Legislature of the State of Mississippi, support and endorse the goal of "25 x 25" whereby agriculture will provide 25% of the total energy consumed in the United States by the year 2025, while continuing to produce abundant, safe and affordable food and fiber.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislature memorializes the President and Congress of the United States to support the "25 x 25" goal promoting the use of agricultural-based renewable energy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State of Mississippi is directed to send copies of this resolution to President George W. Bush, the Secretary of the United States Senate, the Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, the Secretary of the United States Department of Energy, the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture, and each member of the Mississippi congressional delegation.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE PRESIDENT AND
CONGRESS TO SUPPORT THE "25 X 25" GOAL PROMOTING
AGRICULTURAL-BASED RENEWABLE ENERGY.
