1 AMEND by inserting the following after line 894 and by 2 renumbering subsequent sections accordingly:

3 SECTION *. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 4 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 5 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 6 7 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of 8 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this 9 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor 10 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a supporter of the Clinton Community Nature Center. 11 The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the 12 State Tax Commission, with the advice of the Board of Trustees of 13 14 Clinton Community Nature Center, may prescribe and shall consist 15 of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag. 16

17 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 18 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 19 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the 20 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less 21 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 22 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis 23 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional

24 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 25 county general fund.

26 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or 27 after July 1, 2007, any person applying for a distinctive license 28 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 29 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 30 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 31 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established 32 33 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive license 34 35 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 36 37 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 38 39 collector.

40 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the 41 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month, 42 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the 43 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the 44 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State 45 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

46 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
47 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
48 section shall be distributed to the Clinton Community Nature
49 Center.

50 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected 51 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall 52 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Fund created pursuant 53 to Section 7-9-70.

54 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee 55 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this

56 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund 57 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or 58 reconstruction of highways.

(d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
27-19-44.2.

63 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 64 65 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 66 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 67 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 68 69 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 70 tag.

In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 71 (6) 72 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and 73 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 74 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 75 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving 76 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 77 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 78 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 79 80 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

81 FURTHER amend line 22 of the title by inserting the following 82 after the semicolon:

83 TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE 84 TAGS TO SUPPORTERS OF THE CLINTON COMMUNITY NATURE CENTER;
