## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State

11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
14	Authority for Educational Television which is comprised of special
15	source funds collected by or otherwise available to the Authority,
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Authority for the
17	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2007, and ending June 30, 2008
18	\$ 5,099,962.00
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
21	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
22	expenditure:

45	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
46	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
47	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
48	Plan or One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or Three Percent (3%)
49	whichever is greater, to be awarded on July 1, 2007.
50	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
51	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
52	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
53	Services" for Fiscal Year 2009 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2008
54	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
55	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2009 budget by the

- 56 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 57 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 58 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 59 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 60 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 61 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 62 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2008 appropriation for "Personal
- 63 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 64 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 65 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 66 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 67 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2008 "Personal Services"
- 68 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 69 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 70 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 71 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 72 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 73 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 74 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 75 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 76 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 77 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 78 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 79 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 80 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 82 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 83 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 84 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- The agency shall not take any action to promote or otherwise
- 86 award salary increases through reallocation, reclassification,
- 87 realignment, education benchmark, career ladder, or any other

- 88 means to increase salaries of employees or positions unless
- 89 specifically exempted by the following conditions: the award of
- 90 teacher pay increases, the advancement of a trainee/cadet to the
- 91 next level of a bona fide career ladder, the award of an
- 92 educational benchmark for the attainment of Certified Public
- 93 Accountant License or higher level professional certification as
- 94 determined by the State Personnel Board, the immediate replacement
- 95 of a departing employee with an individual from within state
- 96 service or a new hire at a salary level equivalent to that of the
- 97 departing employee, and the emergency appointment of nurses,
- 98 pharmacists or other health care professionals at a salary to be
- 99 determined by the State Personnel Board, unless otherwise
- 100 authorized in this act.
- 101 Funds appropriated herein shall first be used for the
- 102 continuation of a full and complete broadcast schedule of
- 103 educational and instructional, professional growth, and public
- 104 service programs, with the production of new films and programs to
- 105 be secondary thereto.
- 106 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 107 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall maintain
- 108 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 109 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 110 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 111 maintained for Fiscal Year 2007. It is further the intention of
- 112 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 113 2009 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 115 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2008 budget request
- 116 process.
- 117 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 118 Section 2, One Million Six Hundred Forty-four Thousand Sixty-seven
- 119 Dollars (\$1,644,067.00) shall be derived from the Education

178	SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature t	hat
179	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency	for the
180	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all thi	ngs

182	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Bl	ind
183	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be	given to

- the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.
- section 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that an amount equal to One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per square foot shall be paid to the Executive Office of the State Board of
- 189 Institutions of Higher Learning to defray utility costs.
- section 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
  the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
  credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
  warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
  Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
  proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
